This fantastic substantial property offers spacious accommodation with kitchen/breakfast room, dining room/bedroom five, log burning stove, four piece bathroom suite with spa bath, good sized gardens, garden office/studio, garage (currently divided into gym and storage) gas central heating and UPVC double glazing.

Briefly, the property offers entrance hall, lounge, dining room/bedroom five, kitchen/breakfast room, cloakroom with WC, four bedrooms to the first floor, bathroom, divided garage, garden office/studio, gardens, parking, gas central heating and UPVC double glazing.

WATTON

Swaffham 10 miles; Thetford 15 miles; Norwich 23 miles

The well-served market town of Watton is in the district of Breckland, just less than 25 miles from Norwich. Perfectly positioned for access to the whole of Norfolk and North Suffolk, this town is

thought to be where the `Babes in the Wood' were abandoned in Wayland Wood. You will see on the town sign that there are two babes, and a hare jumping over the barrel reflecting the town name; 'wat' being the local dialect word for hare, and 'ton' for barrel. There is a traditional market held every Wednesday morning with produce including freshly caught fish, and there are two supermarkets and a number of independent shops, cafes, restaurants and pubs to enjoy. Within reach is the popular Thetford Forest Park, a number of golf courses, other market towns and not forgetting the cathedral city of Norwich.

Bathroom

Four piece bathroom suite comprising spa bath, shower cubicle, wash basin set within fitted cabinet, WC, tiled splashback, tiles to floor, towel radiator, light tunnel, extractor fan.

Garage

Single garage currently divided into two with a stud partition wall, used as office and gym. Straight forward removal of stud wall if full sized garage was required again. Insulated extension to rear of garage currently used as an office and storage.

Outside Front

Front garden laid to lawn, driveway providing off road parking, established tree, gated access to rear garden, wooden garden shed, outside light.

Rear Garden

Enclosed rear garden laid to lawn, wooden decked seating area to rear of garden, shrubs and plants to borders, wooden fence and hedge to perimeter, gated access to front.
