road, while to the rear, a private patio garden offers the perfect space for outdoor relaxation.

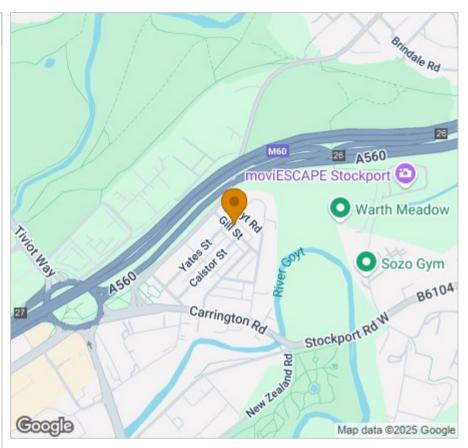

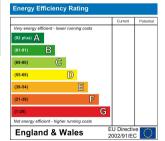

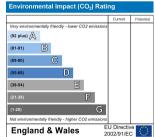
Floor Plan Area Map
