Front aspect secondary glazed Yorkshire sash window and a feature fireplace (previously the furnace to the old forge room) provides a impressive focal point to the room. A spiral staircase provides access to the middle floor living room.

Middle floor

Dining Kitchen

Comprising a range of fitted base and wall units with matching work surfaces.

Appliances to include: Belfast sink with mixer tap, "Smeg" electric oven with six ring gas hob (via calor gas) dishwasher and plumbing for washing machine. Front aspect secondary glazed window and a single stable door provides access to the rear garden.

Dual aspect secondary glazed Yorkshire sash windows and a log burning stove providing a cosy focal point to the room.

Traditional style white suite comprising: Shower enclosure with wall mounted electric shower, pedestal wash hand basin and WC.

A garage and workshop is situated towards the side and rear of the property and provides a very useful storage area.













Lower Ground Floor Approx 47 sq m / 507 sq ft
