Under Phase 3 of a multi-million-pound makeover, Darlington Market will house a dozen new artisans and traders such as barbers, beauticians, tattooists, traditional over-the-counter businesses, high-quality fashion, and food in purpose-built, artisinal kiosks based on the blueprint of 4 unique, contemporary designs

- A catalyst for the rejuvenation of Darlington's High Street

DESIGN A *The Sculpture*

A folly for the professional, the tattooist, the barber, the beautician...

The design will create intrigue both during and after hours of regular trading, while also allowing for an amount of privacy for the services it will facilitate

The reflective materials will place the sulpture within it's eclectic setting while celebrating the surrounding offerings

The design takes inspiration from the American Air Stream Caravans, providing a unique characterisation for potential tenants and trade



DESIGN B The Cabinet Of Curiosity

A display opportunity for the retailer, the collector, the boutique, the exhibitionist, the artist...

Appearing above the adjacent stalls, utilising the full footprint, this design provides opportunity for occupiers to create their own environment within the market setting

DESIGN C The Biophilic

An inviting open curved structure, which encourages participation and celebrates biophilic design, as the stall will increase occupant and customer connectivity to the natural environment through the use of sustainable and locally sourced materials

Envisaged trades include the florist, the potter, the deli, and the coffee roaster


DESIGN D The Alley

The curved arches celebrate the historic geometry of the market fabric, while residing beneath a forgotten tradition of multi-cross trading opportunities where at the end of the working day the manager would ring a bell to signify discounted rates for fellow traders
