Situation

Rigfoot is situated 5 miles away from the town of Langholm, also known colloquially as the 'Muckle Toon', which is a burgh in Dumfries and Galloway in southern Scotland. Langholm lies between four hills in the valley of the River Esk in the Southern Uplands. It is the traditional seat of Clan Armstrong with its most famous descendant being Neil Armstrong, the first man to walk on the Moon. Langholm sits 8 miles North of the Anglo-Scottish Border on the A7 road running between Edinburgh in east central Scotland and Carlisle in North-West England. Edinburgh is 73 miles to the north, Newcastle is around 10 miles to the East and Carlisle 19 miles to the South. The town hosts various amenities including a health centre, primary and secondary school and youth facilities. There is a library, supermarket and a range of independent shops and businesses, hotels, a 24 hour petrol station, a sports centre and a golf course. The Buccleuch Centre is a busy venue for entertainment and community events and also has its own café.
