The property is full of warmth and personality, thoughtfully arranged across three levels to provide versatile living. A welcoming sitting room at the front of

the house sets the tone, with the original features and proportions lending a cosy, homely atmosphere. Further down the hallway, the dining room connects directly to a stylish Shaker-style kitchen, complete with plentiful worktop space. A door from the kitchen opens out into the rear garden, while a separate doorway leads to a full ground floor bathroom — perfect for guests or family use.

One of the standout features of this home is the converted cellar, currently used as a playroom but previously enjoyed as a snug and occasional bedroom. Its flexibility and privacy make it ideal for a variety of needs, whether that's a quiet retreat, home office, or additional family space.

Upstairs, the property boasts three double bedrooms, each with a generous footprint. The principal bedroom benefits from a modern en-suite shower room, whilst the other two bedrooms, both fitted with built in wardrobe space, are served by the downstairs bathroom.
