















SECOND FLOOR

Outside, a pretty pedestrian pathway leads to the property, enclosed by a picket fence and bordered with mature shrubs and fruit trees. The garden provides a mix of patio seating areas, a central lawn, and an original well, while steps lead to a raised, split-level garden that gently ascends towards open countryside. Myrtle Cottage is a delightful home offering character, comfort, and peace in a rarely available village setting.

The hamlet of Finchdean is close to the desirable village of Rowlands Castle. This village straddles the West Sussex and Hampshire borders in the South Downs National Park. There are plenty of opportunities for rural pursuits, including a golf course nearby, tennis club and Stanstead estate for walking. There are 3 pubs, hardware and general stores and a Post Office. The village also has a surgery with a pharmacy, all within walking distance. Furthermore, Rowlands Castle has a Montessori Nursery school and also a primary school together with amenities for day to day needs, as well as a mainline rail station on the London to Portsmouth line.
