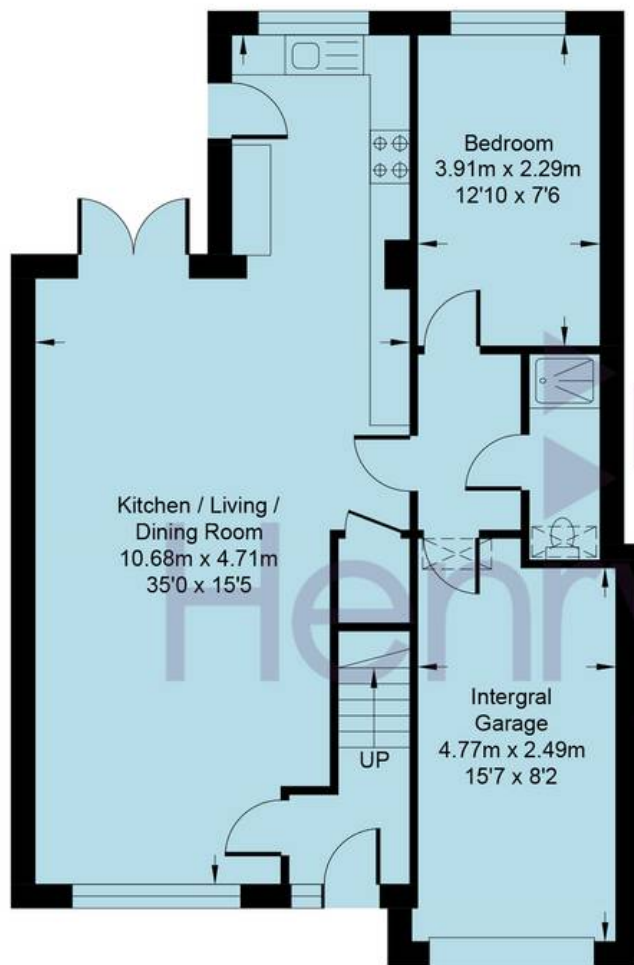

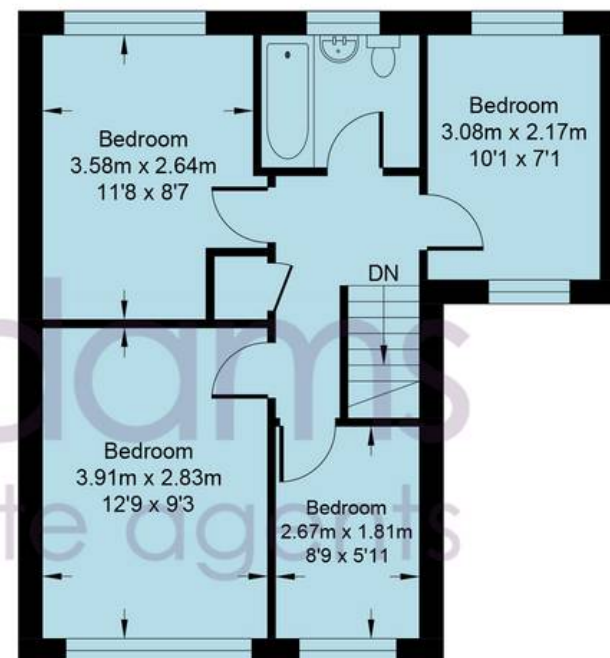

A neighbourly cul-de-sac position and the quietness of Rushwood Close which is located off Beech Hill, just off Northlands Avenue. The house is ideally situated within a short walk of a Tesco Express, doctors surgery and chemist, Northlands Wood Primary School and the Princess Royal Hospital. Haywards Heath mainline train station and town centre are also within easy reach. Haywards Heath town centre provides extensive shopping facilities including Orchards Shopping Centre and cafes, as well as a variety of bars & restaurants situated on The Broadway. Schools are well represented with Oathall Secondary School, St Joseph's Primary School, St Wilfrid's Primary School and Warden Park Primary School all located within walking distance.

The surrounding area is also the home of several excellent independent schools including Hurstpierpoint College, Ardingly College, Worth Abbey, Great Walstead, Cumnor House and Burgess Hill Girls. Haywards Heath mainline station is located within walking distance from the house and offers regular services to London (approximately 47minutes to London Bridge/Victoria), Brighton (20 minutes) and Gatwick Airport (20 minutes). By car, surrounding areas can be accessed via the A272 and A23/M23 with links to Brighton, Gatwick Airport and London.
