

This exceptional semi-detached home, built in 1901, is a stunning blend of Victorian ornate detailing and Edwardian grandeur. Set across four expansive storeys, this distinguished home boasts breathtaking views across Reigate Hill and exudes charm, elegance, and warmth.

The striking red-brick facade, complemented by a walled front garden and a meandering pathway leading to the porch, creates a captivating first impression. The impressive entrance, framed by a large traditional porch with glass and brick accents, welcomes you into a generous hallway. Here, soaring ceilings, intricate coving, and a sweeping staircase set the tone for the home's remarkable sense of space and refinement. A downstairs WC and convenient coat storage enhance the practicality of this inviting space.

The formal front reception room is a masterpiece of period charm, featuring a grand bay window with bespoke shutters, an ornate ceiling rose, and an intricately carved fireplace adorned with Victorian tiles. The rear of the home has been beautifully extended to bathe the space in natural light.

A second reception room, complete with a working log burner and built-in shelving, flows seamlessly into the exquisite kitchen and dining area. The kitchen, a perfect balance of classic and contemporary design, showcases neutral in-line shaker cabinetry, granite worktops, and a central island that subtly zones the space. Thoughtful details include a bespoke pantry cupboard with internal storage and a second concealed unit including a coffee and toaster station.



Double doors lead down into a large walled garden. A striking feature of the home is the cleverly designed stairwell leading to the lower ground floor—a truly versatile space that offers endless possibilities. Whether used as a home studio, gym, additional accommodation, or a games room, this level enjoys impressive glass sliding doors that open directly onto the patio, creating a seamless indoor-outdoor flow.

There is off-road parking on Cockshot Road, with a driveway and double garage offering garden access. A large utility room adjacent to the kitchen and an additional basement storage area further enhance the home's practicality.

The upper floors house five spacious bedrooms, offering an exceptional level of accommodation. The first floor is home to the principal bedroom, a tranquil retreat with an ornate tiled fireplace, an expansive bay window, and an en-suite shower room featuring double sinks and a luxurious modern design. Two additional double bedrooms on this level enjoy breathtaking views of Reigate Hill and are served by a stylish family shower room.

The second floor presents another potential principal suite—a vast, characterful space featuring a period fireplace, a large dormer window framing spectacular views, and a generous en-suite bathroom with a separate shower. A fifth bedroom, currently used as a study, along with original built-in wardrobes on the landing, complete this floor.











Smoke Lane is perfectly positioned for those who enjoy the best of Reigate's outdoor spaces, with Priory Park just a short walk away via a pedestrian pathway down the hill.
