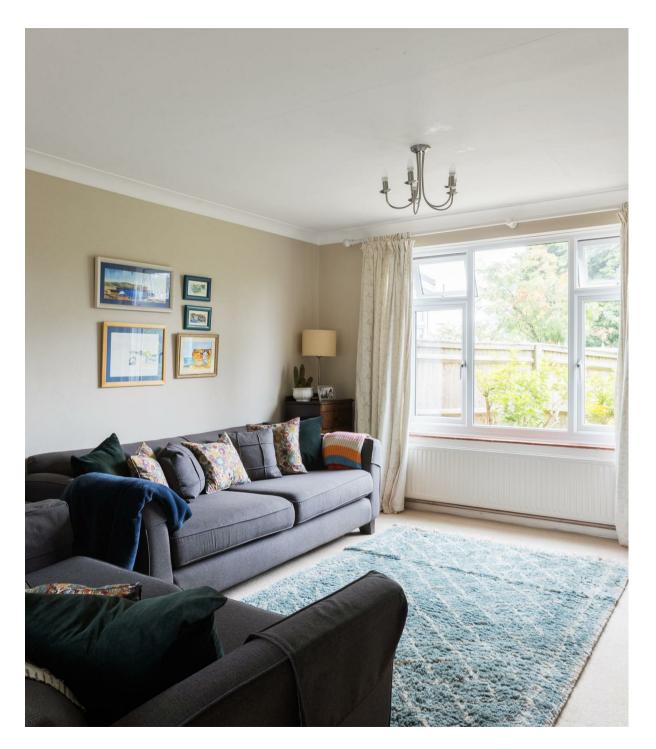

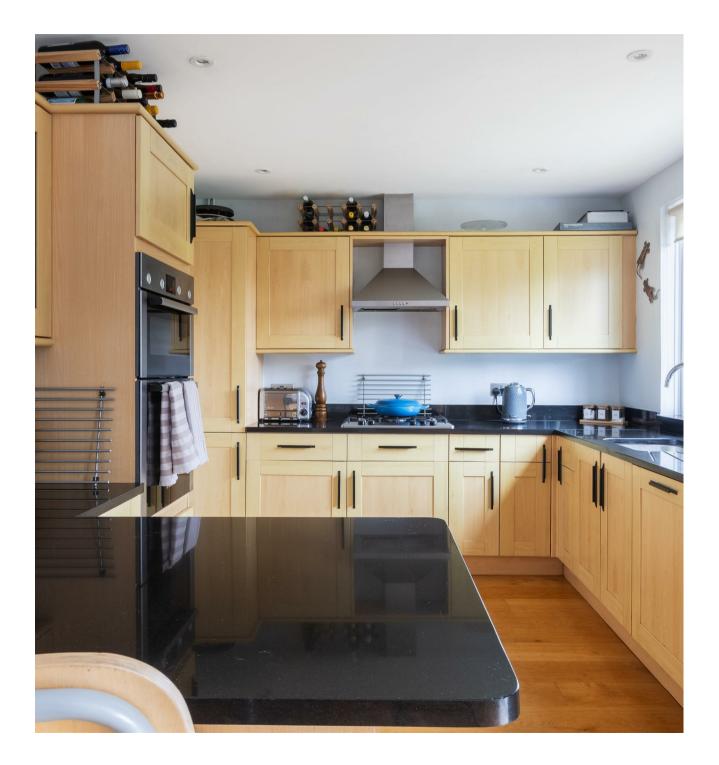

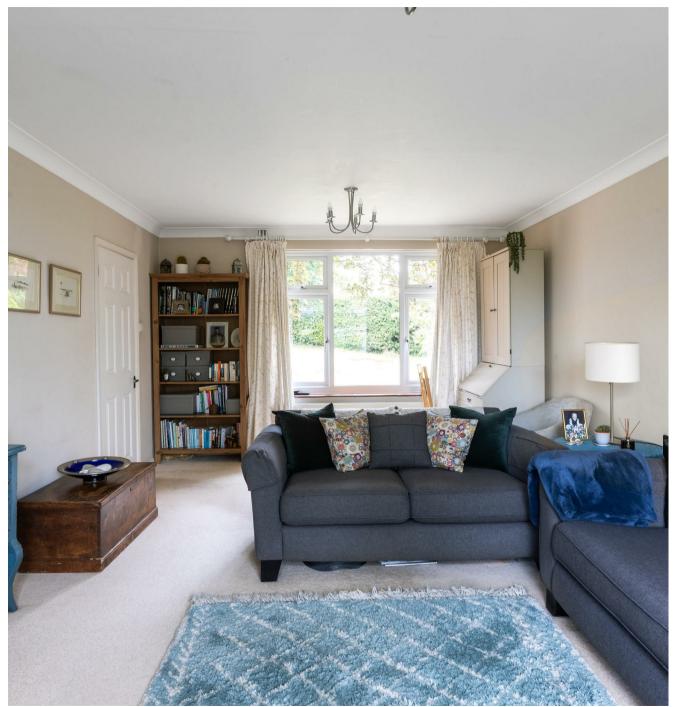
Opposite, the open plan kitchen and dining room is a masterclass in functional beauty. Zoned by a breakfast bar, the space invites every kind of moment: morning coffees with the first light filtering in, homework done with one eye on the oven timer, family meals with the French doors flung open onto the garden beyond.



Step outside and you're greeted by a true family-friendly garden: generous in scale, wrapped in greenery, and perfectly positioned to follow the path of the sun from dawn to sunset. With a large lawn for play, planting borders ready to burst into bloom, and a southwest-facing orientation that brings golden light into the evenings, this is a garden to grow with, ideal for everything from summer parties to peaceful evening unwinds.

A downstairs WC completes the ground floor, while upstairs, four well-proportioned bedrooms branch off a central hallway. Three doubles and a generous single offer flexibility for family life, with the principal bedroom enjoying the privacy of its own ensuite shower room. The home offers generous storage and scope for future expansion (stpp).









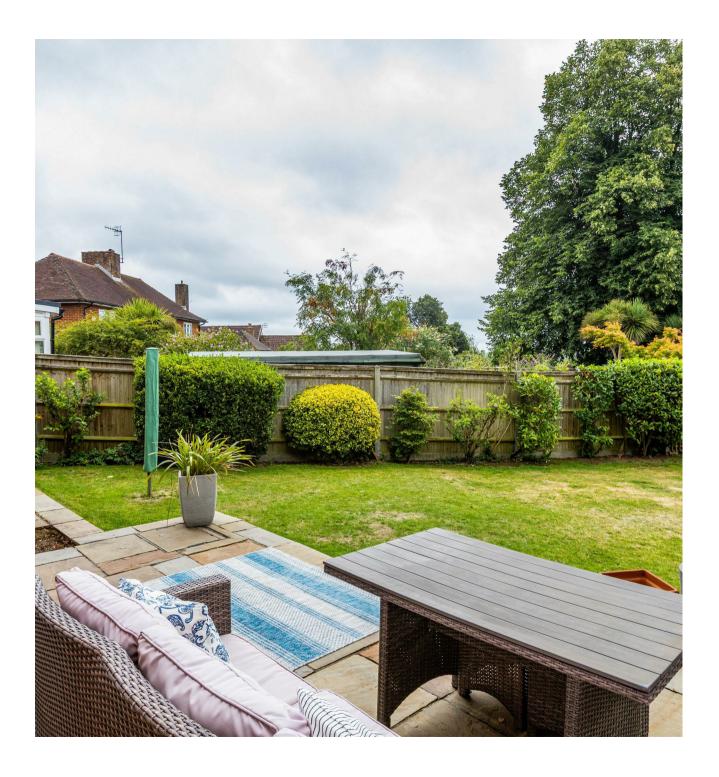

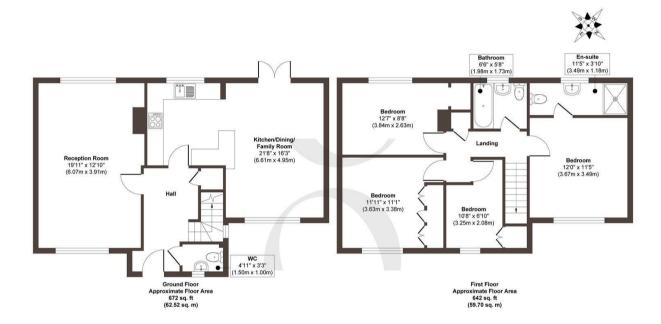
