Beyond, the home begins to reveal its more practical side: a w.c. with the potential to be transformed into a shower room, and a basement below that provides generous storage. Yet the true heart of the home is found in the open reception, dining, and kitchen area. Here, oak cabinetry adds a sense of timeless solidity, while the adjoining conservatory floods the space with natural light—perfect for lingering over morning coffee as the garden begins to stir outside. From here, French doors open to the garden, connecting indoors and out with effortless charm.




