

Head up onto the first floor and open your front door, to find your bathroom immediately to your right. There's a sleek white suite including a freestanding rolltop tub and vanity sink. The walls are part tiled in simple white, and it's all bathed in natural light. Next is your fantastic kitchen, diner and lounge straight ahead of you. Giving you more than 500 square foot of versatile space, along with gorgeous parquet flooring underfoot, and dual aspect windows looking over the communal gardens.

Cambridge Heath station is a six minute walk. From here the Overground will speed you to Liverpool Street in another seven minutes and you are only a twelve minute walk to Bethnal Green Station for the central line. As for green spaces, Haggerston Park is three minutes from your new home, and contains both a city farm (with Italian cafe) and community orchard. London's legendary Victoria Park is less than a mile away, while Columbia Road with its wonderful, famous flower market is a four minute stroll from you.

- Your new local is The Virgin Queen, a beautiful historic pub by Broadway Market, with a mouthwatering menu.
- Under twenty minutes takes you to bustling Brick Lane, London's curry haven that's also home to the famous 24-hour Beigel Bake bakery.
