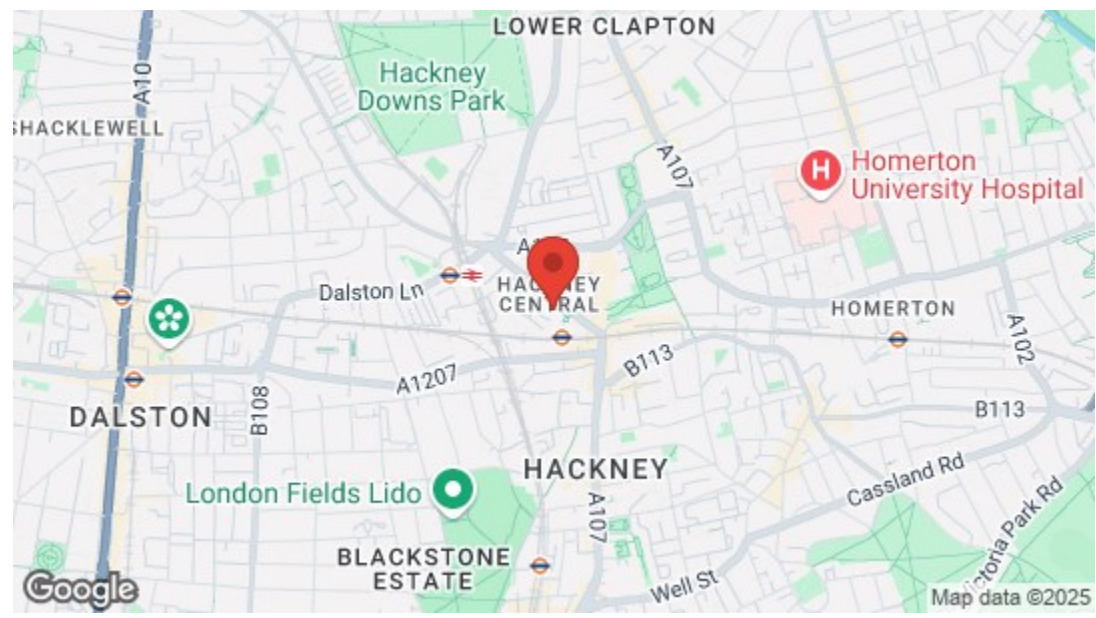

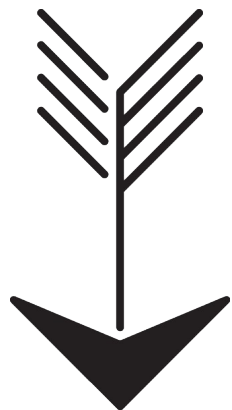

Once through your dedicated entrance your hallway welcomes you with pale grey engineered hardwood underfoot, as throughout. Your kitchen awaits to the left, neat and practical with an abundance of cupboard space, tiling underfoot, and a gas hob set in glossy black quartz style worktops. Then you'll find your reception, a generous space with a large double sash window allowing for views over the grounds and plentiful natural light.

Your principal bedroom is next door, a solid double, all clean lines, bright white walls and more double glazed sash windows. Bedroom two is back through the reception and off the hallway, another double, similarly styled. Your bathroom is home to a vanity sink, and shower over the panel sided tub. Large format marbled tilework adds a hint of luxury here, while the WC sits handily separated across the hall.

Outside, and it's less than half a mile on foot to Hackney Downs station for the Overground, with the Weaver Line taking you to Liverpool Street in under ten minutes, meaning your commute could be as little as twenty minutes door to door. All your amenities are close at hand too. Hackney's huge array of places to eat, drink, shop, and dance starts just a half mile stroll away, at the top of Mare Street.
