Blonde hardwood floors lead the way from the hallway into a beautifully bright and spacious open-plan kitchen and reception room stretching over 25 feet. The space feels effortlessly airy, thanks to dual-aspect windows, twin skylights, and wide bifold doors that open onto the garden. Come evening, soft spotlights take over to create a warm, relaxed vibe. With built-in cabinetry, there's no shortage of cupboards or shelving and even a built-in desk - perfect for those wanting to work from home.

The kitchen area is stylish and social, with a mix of grey and natural wood cabinetry housing integrated appliances under crisp white countertops. A central island adds more prep space, doubles as a breakfast bar, and makes hosting feel easy and natural. Built-in seating along the rear offers calming views of the garden while you sip coffee

And what a garden! Spanning over 70 feet, it's been thoughtfully landscaped with a patio right off the kitchen, perfect for al fresco dining. The neat lawn extends to a further paved spot at the back, flanked by mature planting and neat walled borders
