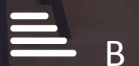




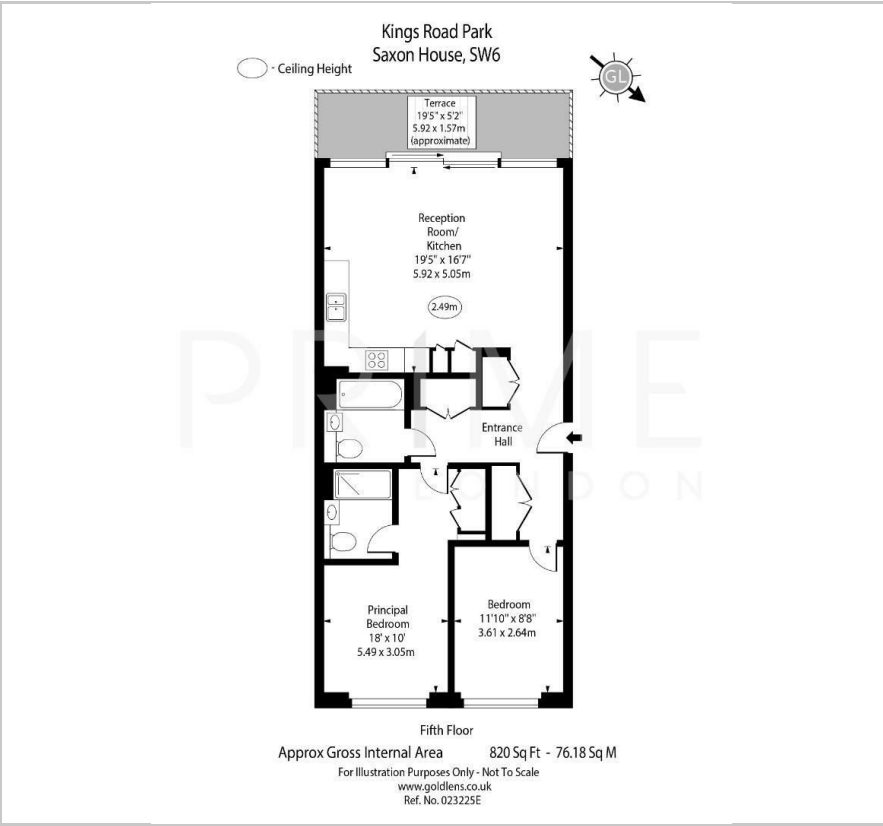

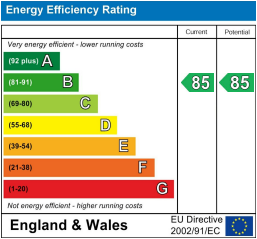
Floor Plan
