A large loft conversion was added in 2015 to create a fabulous master bedroom, dressing room and bath/shower room.



## in more detail...

A substantial 5 bedroom, 3 bath/shower room detached house offering much larger accommodation than is evident from an external viewing due to a loft conversion to create a generous master bedroom, a dressing room and a bath/shower room.

The property was built by Beazer Homes in 1998 situated on a corner plot forming part of this sought after residential area within a short walk of Southways and Gattons schools, St Pauls Catholic College and the Triangle Leisure Centre.

The accommodation comprises an entrance hall with stairs to the first floor, a cloakroom and a living room with double bifold doors (2015) opening onto the rear garden.

The dual aspect kitchen/dining room is a particularly good size with a door to the rear garden. The kitchen has been refitted with gloss cupboards complimented by integrated cooking appliances.

On the first floor there is a guest bedroom with built in wardrobes and an ensuite shower room with power shower. There are 3 further bedrooms and a family bathroom.

A staircase leads from the landing to the fabulous dual aspect master bedroom added in 2015 with far reaching views as far as the South Downs. There is a separate dressing room with a window and a luxuriously appointed bathroom with a separate double size shower cubicle with 2 power showers.



**Outside** a private block paved driveway provides parking for 2 cars leading to the integral garage with a personal door to the hallway. A side gate opens onto the 45' x 33' south facing rear garden which was landscaped in 2015. A full width flagstone patio abuts the house with the majority laid to level lawn enclosed by a picket fence.


A gate leads to a secondary area of wild garden with timber and paved patios and a brook beneath. The garden is partially walled.

**Benefits** include gas fired central heating (the boiler is located in the airing cupboard) and sealed unit double glazed windows.


