

The property is located at the southern end of Frankton Avenue close to the Hospital, Birch Hotel and a petrol station with a Coop. Nearby facilities include the Franklands Village Store, a Tesco Express, medical centre and pharmacy. The nearest primary schools are Northlands Wood and St Wilfrid's. Children go onto Oathall Community College with its farm in neighbouring Lindfield and some go onto Warden Park Secondary Academy in Cuckfield. St Paul's College is about 5 miles distant in Burgess Hill. There are several excellent independent schools including Great Walstead, Cumnor House, Ardingly, Worth, Burgess Hill Girls, Brighton College, Roedean, Bedes and Lancing College and they all provide a bus service with pickup point close by. The town centre is within a 10/15minute walk where there is an extensive range of shops and stores whilst the town's fashionable Broadway is a little further on with its many restaurants, cafes and bars. The railway station provides fast commuter services to London, Gatwick Airport and Brighton. The town has a leisure centre, 6th form college, numerous sports clubs and leisure groups and the surrounding area has several golf courses and beauty spots including both Ditchling and Chailey Common Nature Reserves, the Ashdown Forest and the South Downs National Park. By road access to the major surrounding areas can be swiftly gained via the A272, B2112 and the A/M23 which lies about 6 miles to the west at Bolney or Warninglid.
