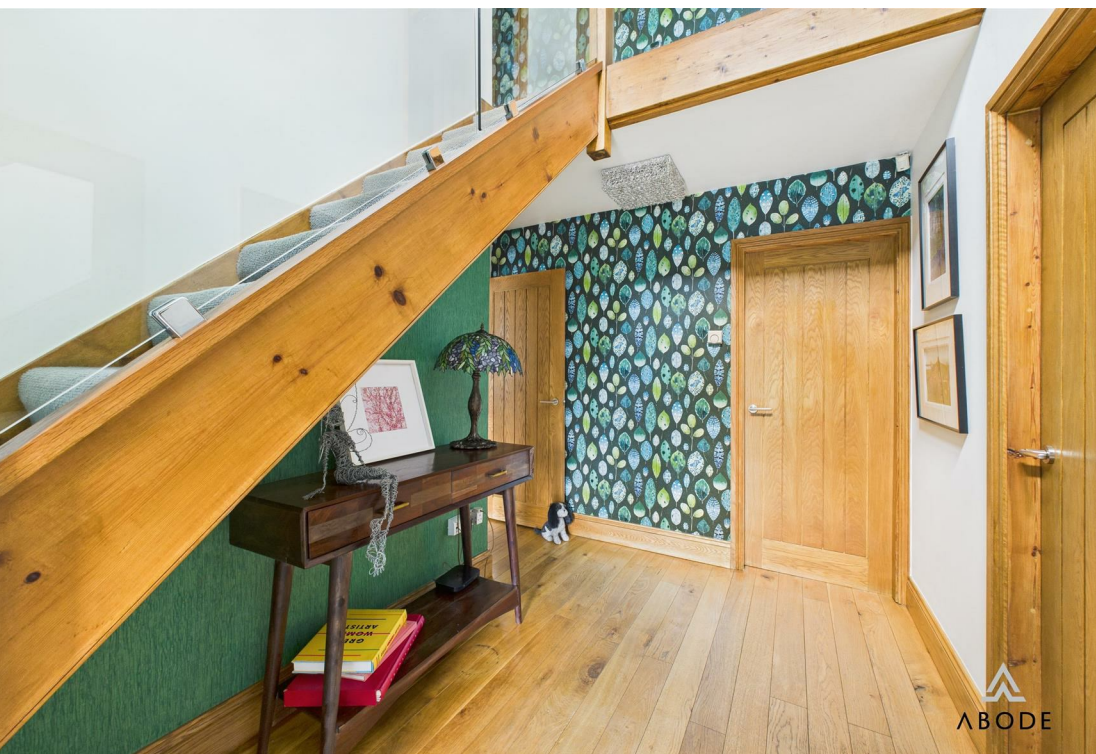


Oakleigh House High Street, Stoke-On-Trent, ST10 2PE

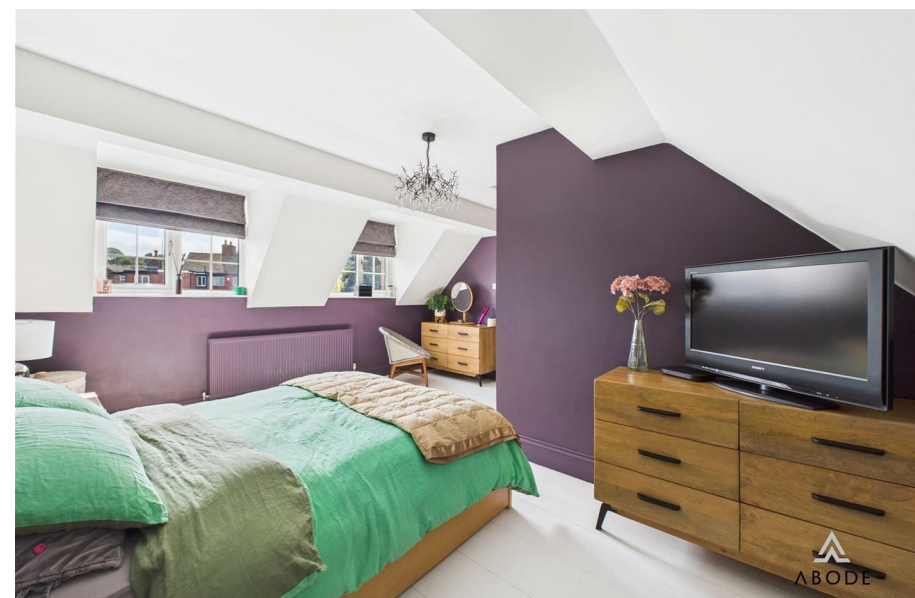

This well-maintained home is available for long-term rental and offers the perfect blend of comfort, space, and style for those seeking a tranquil living environment.







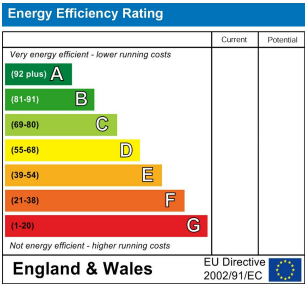
Floor Plans
