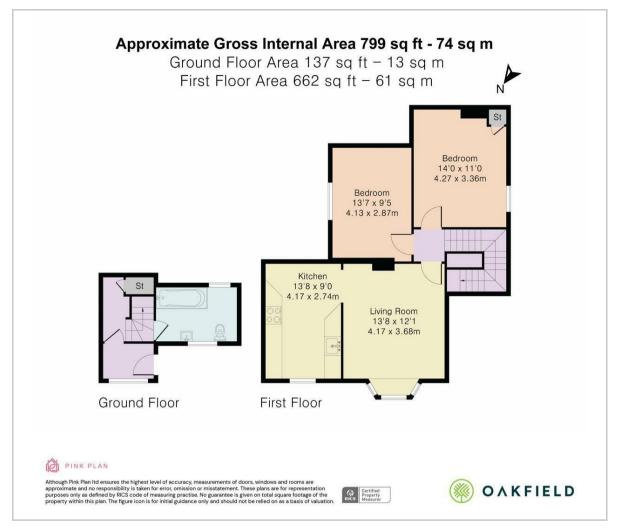

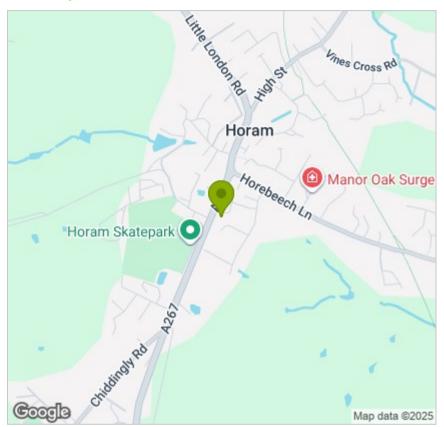
Floor Plan Area Map



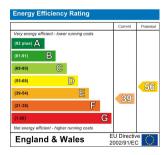
