



The Coal Authority has records of over 175,000 mine entries within the UK captured in the National Coal Mining database, derived from sources including abandonment plans, geological and topographical plans.


Coal mining activity is recorded as far back as the 13th century, but prior to 1872 there was no requirement to deposit abandonment plans. It is therefore believed there may be many unrecorded mine entries of which the Authority has no information or knowledge. These entries do not, therefore, appear within the Authority's national dataset as shown on this map.



### Rail Noise Data

The data indicates the annual average noise levels for the 16-hour period between 0700 - 2300.




- **High Risk** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 30 (3.3%) in any one year.
- **Medium Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 100 (1.0%) in any one year.
- **Low Risk -** an area which has a chance of flooding of greater than 1 in 1000 (0.1%) in any one year.
- **Very Low Risk -** an area in which the risk is below 1 in 1000 (0.1%) in any one year.

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




## **Surface Water - Flood Risk**











# Environment Radon Gas



#### What is Radon?

Radon is a natural radioactive gas, which enters buildings from the ground. Exposure to high concentrations increases the risk of lung cancer. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) recommends that radon levels should be reduced in homes where the annual average is at or above 200 becquerels per cubic metre (200 Bq/m3).








# Local Area Road Noise

This indicates a 24 hour annual average noise level with separate weightings for the evening and night periods.
