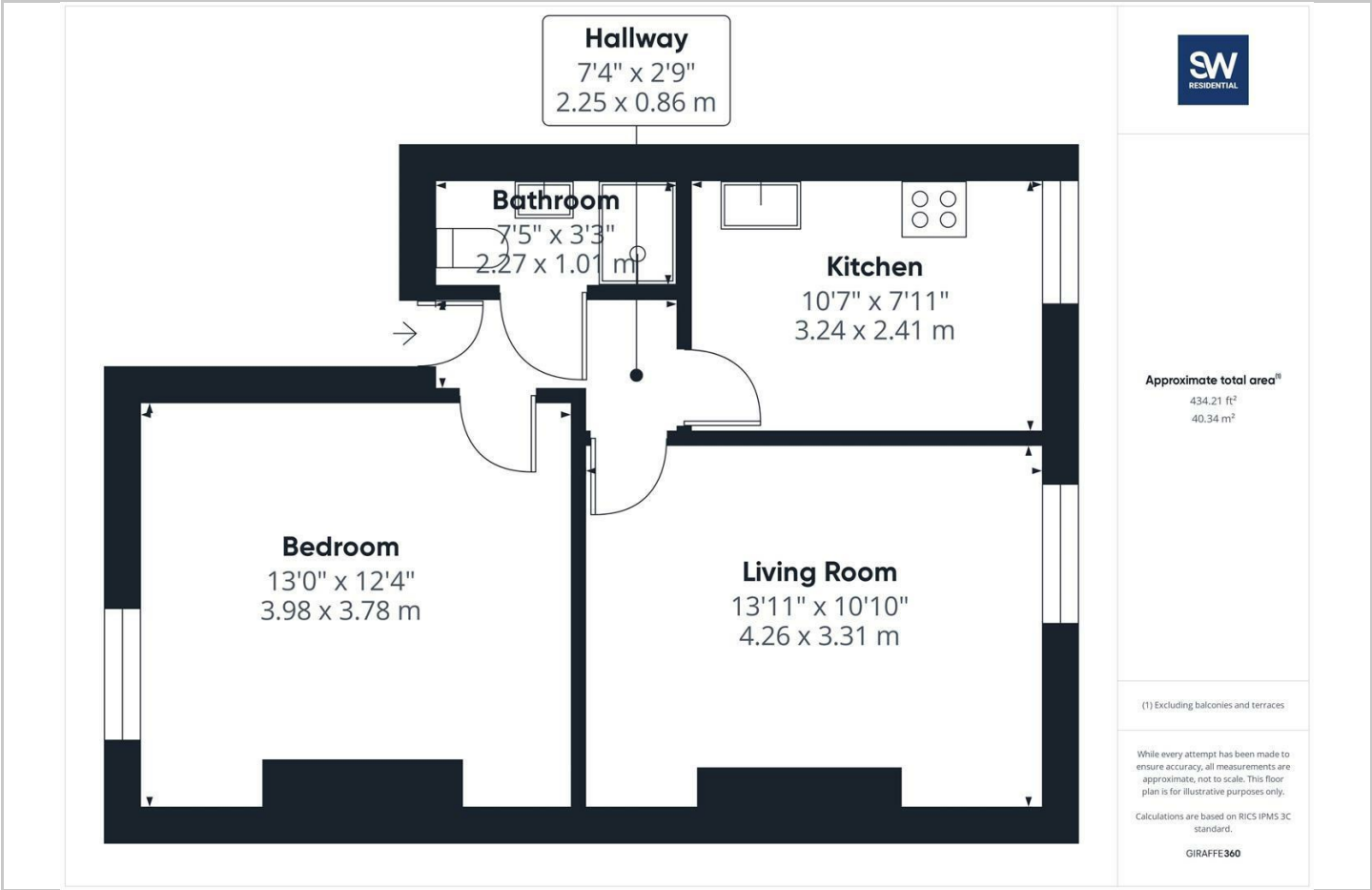

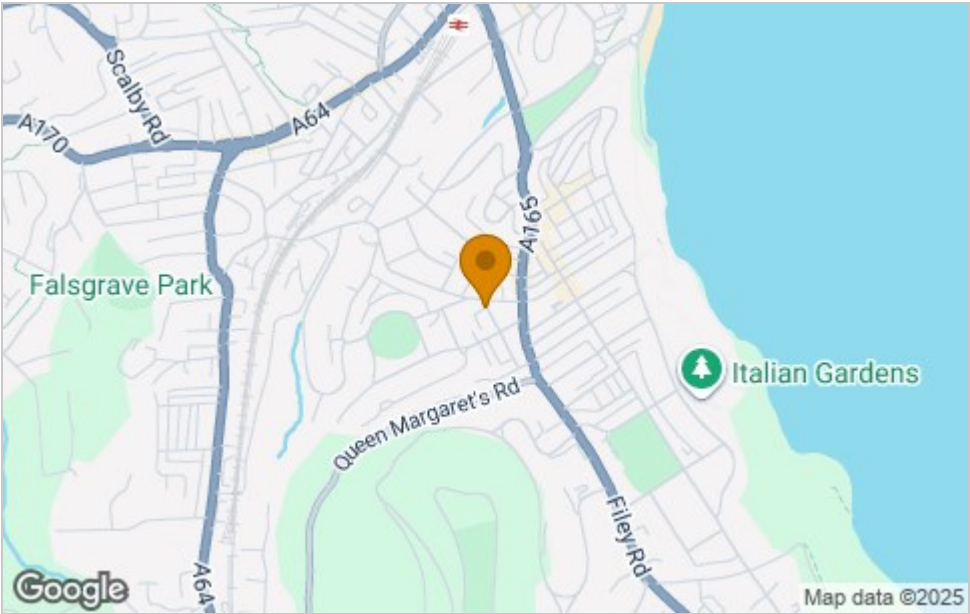




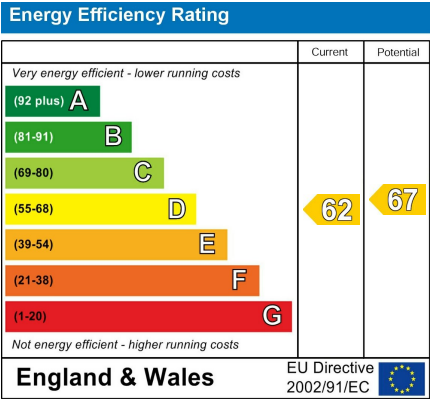
Floor Plan
