The double garage with a flexible room above is ideal for a home office, studio, or gym. With its exceptional setting and thoughtful design, this is a perfect home for modern family living.

This versatile home (2,692 sq ft) occupies a prime position in Poundbury, offering stunning views across The Great Field. Designed with modern family living in mind, the property combines generous living spaces with elegant design, including five bedrooms, a spacious kitchen/breakfast room, a dining/ family room, a large first-floor sitting room with balcony, utility room, family bathroom, two en-suites, and a ground floor WC. A real highlight is the double garage with a versatile room above – perfect as a home office, studio or gym.

The Accommodation

The welcoming entrance hall provides access to all ground floor rooms, including a cloakroom and a useful under-stairs storage cupboard.

The kitchen/breakfast room is beautifully fitted with sleek charcoal cabinetry, granite worktops, and a classic butler's sink. Integrated Neff appliances include a fridge-freezer, five-ring gas hob with extractor, double oven, and dishwasher. The adjoining utility room houses the boiler and offers additional space for appliances. A wide opening flows through to the dining and family area, creating a sociable space that's perfect for everyday living and entertaining family and friends.

On the first floor, the spacious sitting room stretches almost the full width of the home and is centred around a beautiful gas fireplace with an elegant surround and mantle. French doors open onto a balcony with breathtaking 180-degree views over The Great Field – a stunning feature that creates the perfect spot to relax and take in the ever-changing scenery.



Bedroom five (currently used as an office) also has access to the balcony, while bedroom one benefits from its own en-suite shower room.

Three further double bedrooms can be found on the second floor, along with a family bathroom fitted with a panelled bath, separate shower cubicle, WC and wash hand basin.

Outside

The rear garden is a fantastic space for relaxing or entertaining, with a lawned area, a generous patio, and mature planting. There is outdoor lighting, power, and water supply, plus side pedestrian access.

The double garage, with automated doors and power, offers a versatile room above – perfect for working from home or as a hobby space.

Poundbury is an award-winning urban extension of Dorchester, designed around sustainable living and a strong sense of community. Residents enjoy an array of local amenities within walking distance, including cafes, bistros, shops, hairdressers, a medical centre and the highly regarded Damers First School.
