





Beckside Farm stands proud in timeless stone - a graceful country house nestled within its own rolling fields, close to the desirable village of Beckwithshaw and less than a 10-minute drive from central Harrogate. Though enveloped in countryside stillness, it is far from remote. The surrounding area offers all the charm of rural life, with excellent connections placing wider destinations comfortably within reach.

#### A RURAL RETREAT LIKE NO OTHER...

Set within approximately 32 acres in total, the property offers a rare sense of space and seclusion. While all the land is available for purchase, an initial offering of around 2 acres is included with the remainder available by separate negotiation.

This is a home where the old and new exist in harmony - where historic stone and timeworn beams meet modern elegance and family life flows with ease. In total, there is over 4,500 sq. ft. of beautifully considered living accommodation, complemented by an equal amount of ancillary space across a collection of versatile outbuildings including 11 stables, two barns and a field shelter.

Beckside Farm is more than a house - it is a lifestyle shaped by the rhythms of the land and the passage of the seasons. Meticulously restored and sympathetically extended, it balances heritage with modern comfort. Every beam, every pane, every flagstone tells a story - each inviting you to slow down and savour your surroundings.

#### A GRAND ARRIVAL...

As the land unfolds around you, the approach becomes part of the experience - a quiet prelude to the home that awaits.

### AN INVITATION TO GATHER...

Step inside to a welcoming entrance hall, its classic stone-flagged flooring offering a tactile link to the landscape beyond. A sweeping oak staircase rises to a galleried landing above - a dramatic focal point and the perfect place for a Christmas tree to shine beneath the double-height ceiling. Just off the hall lies a WC and beyond that a dedicated study with matching flag flooring - ideal for quiet focus or working from home.





#### HEART OF THE HOME...

At the heart of the home lies an expansive open-plan kitchen and living space. Crafted cabinetry in muted tones kitchen for easy everyday living. In-built oak bookshelves sits beneath elegant Silestone worktops, with an integrated flank the fireplace, adding character, practicality and a dishwasher and a Belfast sink enjoying an outlook over the warm crafted touch. garden. A dark grey dual-fuel AGA - complete with five ovens, twin hot plates and an induction hob - adds both functionality and heritage charm.

#### PRACTICAL SPACES...

Practicality is woven seamlessly into everyday life at Beckside Farm, thanks to a thoughtfully arranged suite of secondary spaces accessed from the kitchen and dining area. Terracotta tiles add warmth underfoot as you step into the rear hall, which quietly anchors the home's more functional zones.

A walk-in pantry lies just off the rear hall, with generous in-built shelving providing ample storage for provisions, cookware and those little luxuries no country kitchen should be without. Further along, the utility room is simple yet refined, with light-toned base units, oak worktops, plumbing for a washing machine and space for a tumble dryer - all tucked neatly out of sight but never out of reach. Discreetly tucked into the layout, a secondary staircase also rises from the rear hall - a charming architectural detail that leads to the bedrooms and games room above, adding a layer of flexibility and flow to this beautifully balanced home.

A glazed door opens directly to the courtyard, perfectly placed for muddy boots, impromptu gardening breaks or quick errands.

Just beyond, the boot room offers a more substantial space for everyday comings and goings. With a countertop and wash basin, a WC and adjoining plant room, it's a space designed for muddy paws and wellused wellies. There's even direct access to the high barn and two of the stables, making early morning feeds or wet-weather checks both quick and convenient.





#### SPACES FOR EVERY MOMENT...

From the main entrance hall, step down two stone steps into the original part of the farmhouse. Here, oak flooring continues through the corridor and into both the sitting room and the drawing room, offering warmth and continuity. While the original front door no longer functions as the main entrance, its presence is still evident welcoming, characterful and perfect for quiet reflection from outside - a subtle nod to the home's past.


The sitting room provides a peaceful retreat with a log-burning stove at its heart while the drawing room - enjoying windows on three elevations - is bathed in natural light and offers captivating views across the garden and surrounding countryside. Both rooms are or evening gatherings.

### SLEEP, DREAM, REPEAT...

Climb the main staircase to the first floor, where a wide landing introduces the upper rooms with space and grace. Each bedroom is positioned to make the most of the elevated outlook, ensuring every window frames a view worth savouring.

The principal suite is a sanctuary, complete with a vaulted ceiling, exposed beams and windows to two elevations that frame breathtaking vistas over open fields. As you enter, fitted wardrobes line one wall, offering practical and unobtrusive storage. The en-suite is finished to an exceptional standard, featuring bespoke tiled flooring, a walk-in shower and premium fixtures - all presented in a timeless, calming palette.

#### **REST & REFRESH...**

There are four further double bedrooms, each with individual charm and views across the surrounding landscape. One benefits from a delightful mezzanine, creating a quiet nook for reading or play. All are generous, a walk-in shower, WC and wash basin, adding flexibility tranquil and designed for restful living.

A traditionally styled house bathroom serves these bedrooms, alongside an additional shower room. The bathroom features a freestanding roll-top bath, walk-in shower, WC and a wash hand basin. Timeless fixtures,

elegant tiling and a soft, heritage palette create a space that feels both refined and restful - perfectly in keeping with the character of the home. The shower room has for family or guests.

At the far end of the landing, a couple of steps lead up to a spacious games room - an adaptable area that could easily become a sixth bedroom, hobby room or teenage hideaway.

## SERVICES & SUSTAINABILITY...

The charm of Beckside Farm is matched by its commitment to modern living. Mains electricity and water provide everyday reliability, while private drainage complies with current regulations. A ground source heat pump delivers sustainable underfloor heating throughout, offering comfort at every step.

Energy efficiency is further supported by roof-mounted solar panels that harness renewable power to reduce environmental impact and running costs. Double glazed timber-framed windows, installed in around 2015 during a full refurbishment of the home, enhance insulation and contribute to a warm, efficient living environment.





# A SETTING OF SERENITY...

Beckside Farm is a haven of natural beauty and rural calm, its grounds stretching across paddocks, pasture, pockets of woodland and wildflower meadows, all bound by mature hedgerows and gently flowing streams. An initial parcel of around 2 acres is included in the sale, with the option to acquire up to approximately 32 acres in total by separate negotiation - giving buyers the freedom to tailor the landscape to their lifestyle.

Over time, the current owners have nurtured the land into a rich and varied habitat. Hundreds of trees have been planted, encouraging wildlife and enhancing the sense of seclusion. In spring, bluebells bloom in a violet sweep along the northern boundary woodland, transforming it into a place of seasonal wonder.

Two becks mark the northern and southern edges of the land, their quiet flow lending the property both its name and its atmosphere. Meandering paths thread through the trees and along the water's edge, revealing shifting views and moments of stillness at every turn.

## A LIFE LIVED OUTDOORS...

To the southerly side of the house a walled garden unfolds - private, spacious and beautifully oriented to overlook the orchard beyond. Lawned gardens offer open, green space for play or quiet enjoyment, while stone-paved terraces invite alfresco dining, morning yoga or moments of stillness, all under open skies.

Thoughtfully landscaped and carefully maintained, the garden offers a sense of calm and connection - a space designed for relaxation as much as beauty. Every corner offers something - a view, a seat, a story.

For equestrian enthusiasts, the facilities at Beckside Farm are outstanding. Eleven stables are arranged with functionality in mind, supported by a high barn, field shelter and two further barns that provide excellent storage and flexibility.

The paddocks and fields are each served by their own water supply, enabling ease of use throughout the year. Whether for private use or as a base for professional pursuits, the layout is thoughtful and efficient.

From the first light of day to twilight over the hills, the land here invites you to wander, to watch and to feel connected - a place where every day brings something new to appreciate.






#### Beckside Farm Total Approx. Floor Area 9328 Sq.ft. (866.5 Sq.M.)
