

### Theme Park Highlights

**Established in 1969**, the park has been sympathetically developed and managed, latterly under the ownership of Brighton Pier Group Plc, as a major attractor in the region.

Offering a good range of themed attractions including numerous fun fair style rides, attractions and play facilities tailored to the under 12s, including Pirate Swinger, Splash Falls, Go Safari play and adventure golf, together with daily live entertainment.

Significant central facilities with plenty of food and beverage, and retail opportunities complementing the business.

Existing built infrastructure (buildings and land) offers huge scope for the further enhancement of the park and visitor offering.



# Situation & Location



Lightwater Valley lies on the eastern fringe of the Yorkshire Dales National Park, approximately 5km to the north of Ripon.

The attractions benefits from good accessibility, with easy road links to (and signage off) the A1 (M) to the east via the A6108 and A61 providing a central location benefitting from a significant immediate catchment area including Yorkshire and the Northeast.

The popular spa town of Harrogate, and the market towns of Masham and Leyburn, are all reasonably close by and the pretty cathedral cities of Ripon and York are within easy reach. This beautiful area attracts both day visitors from the extensive Yorkshire and north east conurbations and longer staying domestic and non-domestic visitors from across the country and worldwide.

This area of North Yorkshire is well regarded tourist destination benefiting from its close proximity to the Nidderdale Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and both the North York Moors National Park and the Yorkshire Dales National Park to the east and west respectively.




Adjacent to Go Safari this former birds of prey centre provides additional storage and workshops.




