

This mid terrace family home offers spacious family living accommodation over 2 floors briefly comprising of and an entrance hall, large living room, open dining kitchen with integrated appliances, breakfast bar and French doors leading out into the rear garden.

On the first floor there a 3 well proportioned bedrooms, and a bathroom with shower over bath.

Outside to the front there is a low maintenance garden with access to the alleyway which leads to the rear.

The rear garden has a patio seating area with a timber decked gazebo. There is a lawned area with steps leading to the far end of the garden where there are 2 timber tool sheds.



The location also offers convenient access to other nearby Shropshire towns, including Shrewsbury, the market town of Bridgnorth, and Much Wenlock.


