LOCATION


Situated between the villages of Englefield Green and Virginia Water. Virginia Water offers excellent local amenities including a range of shops, restaurants, and a mainline train to London Waterloo in approximately 40 minutes. The area is exceptionally well connected, with the M25 just 3.5 miles away, providing swift access to Central London, Heathrow Airport, and the national motorway network.

For leisure, residents are spoiled for choice with the nearby world-famous Wentworth Club, in addition to other prestigious country clubs such as Foxhills, Sunningdale, and the Royal Berkshire. Wonderful walks can be enjoyed at Windsor Great Park and Virginia Water, with polo at Smith's Lawn and the nearby Savill Garden.
