First floor

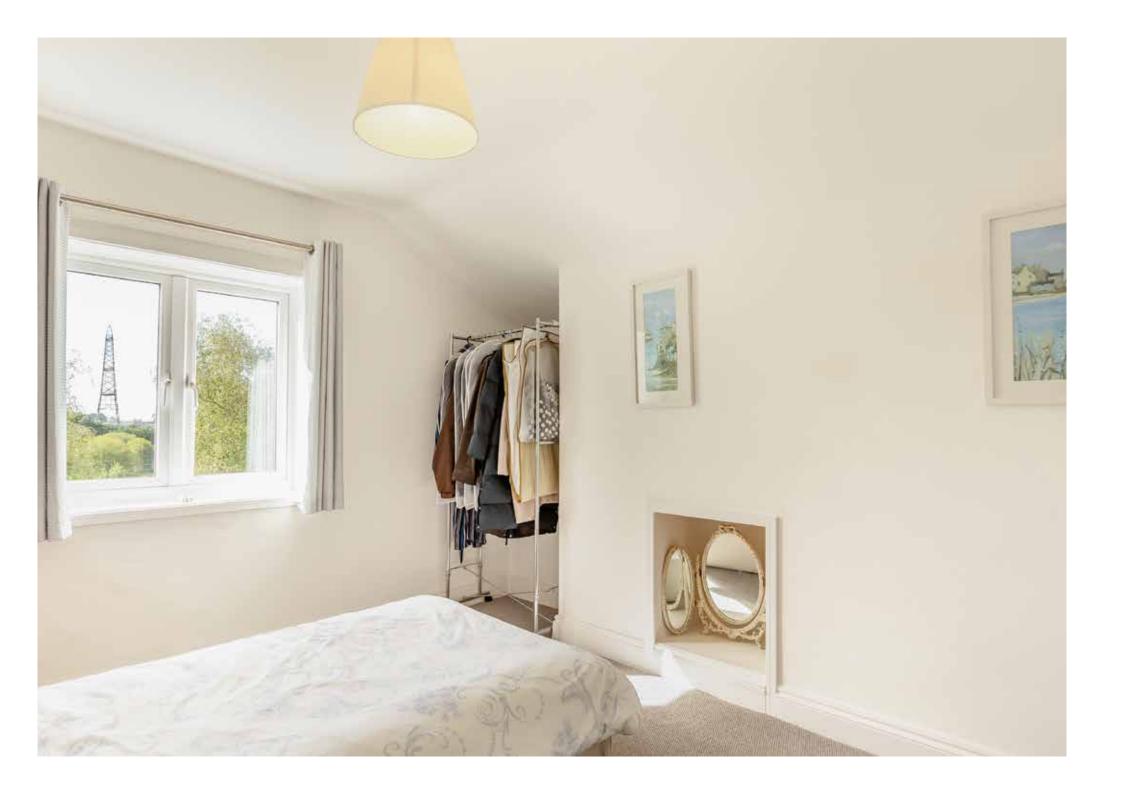

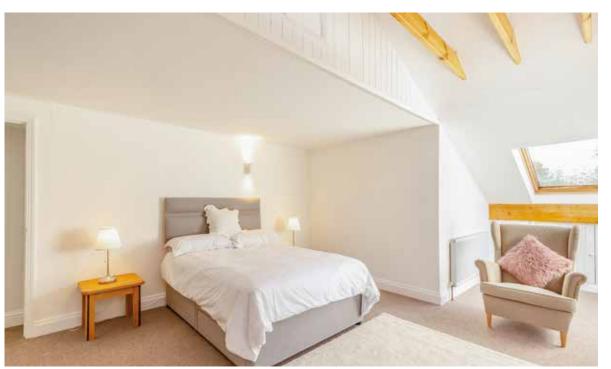












Potential Annexe

You will find the sitting room of the potential annexe next to the living room accessed via the main house. This impressive reception room is a bright and welcoming space, enhanced by its double-height ceiling, exposed beam, and full-height windows. A feature wood-burning stove creates a cosy focal point, with a door providing direct access direct access to the garden, making it an ideal room for both entertaining and everyday family living.

Walking up the stairs to get to the bedroom, there is a landing currently used as an office space with a balcony which offers a delightful spot to enjoy the surrounding gardens and landscape.

The potential annexe bedroom is a standout feature of the home, with its generous proportions, vaulted ceiling, and exposed beams. A skylight and dual-aspect windows flood the space with natural light, creating a serene and airy retreat. The ensuite cloakroom is an added convenience and there is also ample scope to incorporate a useful dressing area.

Gardens and Grounds

The cottage is beautifully positioned within 2.23 acres of gardens, woodland and outbuildings. Ample parking is provided on the gated driveway with an electric car charging port, alongside a detached double garage offering plenty of storage.

The south-facing garden is a true sanctuary, designed for both tranquillity and entertaining. A sun terrace offers ideal space for all fresco dining and summer gatherings, with a delightful piece of historyawell dating back to 1911 when the property was constructed.

Further down, a converted stables offers abundant storage. Here, you have plenty of space for a workshop or even for a ride-on lawn mower to tend to the lush green areas that the property delivers.

Location

Burrowton Cottage is set on the outskirts of the sought-after village of Broadclyst, just five miles from Exeter, offering the perfect balance of rural tranquillity and city convenience. Surrounded by picturesque Devon countryside, the property benefits from excellent local amenities, including shops, pubs, and well-regarded schools such as Broadclyst Community Primary School and Clyst Vale Community College. Cranbrook station and regular bus links provide strong transport connections, while the nearby National Trust's Killerton Estate and scenic walking routes add to the area's charm. 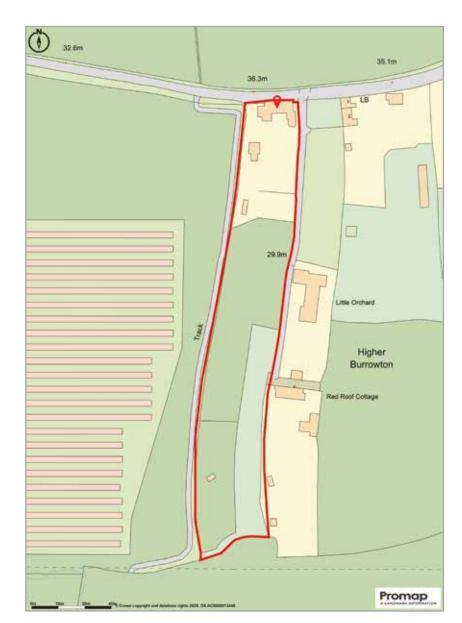

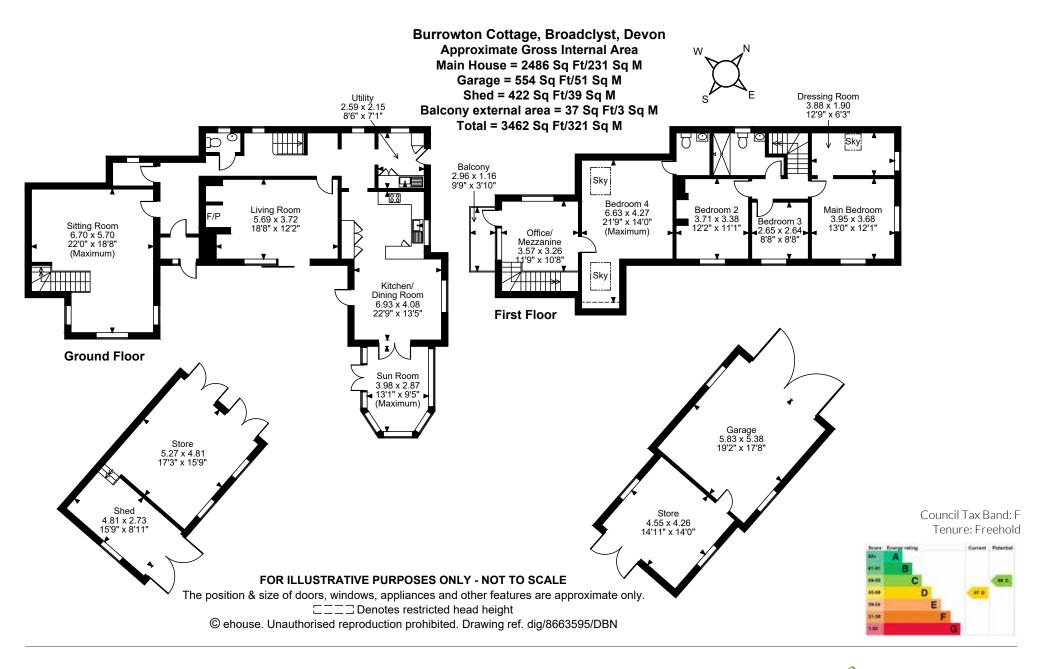

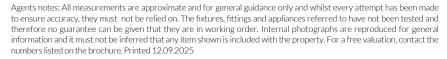
