Whichever design you choose you'll find carefully considered living spaces and a home whose focus on smarter, energy-efficiency feels good to be in while also benefiting the environment. You'll find turfed or landscaped front gardens too, so it feels like home from day one - in a city going places.

Beautifully placed for life

From a wealth of attractions close to home to those of city, countryside and coast.

You'll find a convenience store, Cooperative, and Post Office locally, with a Tesco Extra and Asda Superstore a mile away, and Wrexham's Eagles Meadow Shopping Centre home to names Clogau and Costa, Next and Nando's. Border Retail Park is a mile away, or head to Cheshire Oaks Designer Outlet for Italian, American and British global brands, French cookware and Swiss chocolate stores, just half an hour's drive.

There are friendly hostelries like the Greyhound Inn and The Gate Hangs High, serving cask ales and a warm welcome, with the centre of Wrexham offering traditional watering holes, contemporary cocktail bars and bistro wine bars.

Families will find well-established Abbeyfield Nursery for babies, toddlers and pre-schoolers, Borras Park Community Primary, with Ysgol Rhosnesni High for secondary pupils and Ysgol Morgan Llwyd Welshspeaking school and Sixth Form, all walkable from home.

Rhosnesni and Morgan Llwyd Leisure Centres offer sports, fitness sessions and 3-D pitches with Waterworld Leisure & Activity Centre for rapids, flume fun, gym and cycling studio. Wrexham's Xplore! Science Discovery Centre 'North Wales home of science' inspires all ages, while Tŷ Pawb is a vibrant cultural hub for imaginative play sessions, lunchtime



concerts and comedy nights. Or unwind at Wrexham's multi-screen Odeon and Tenpin Bowl.

Borras Park Albion FC in the Wrexham and District Youth Football League, fields under 8-16s teams, while Wrexham FC is at the Racecourse ground just over 2 miles away. Golfers will enjoy Clays Golf course, driving range and indoor putting, and the renowned Wrexham Golf Club.

Head to Acton Park with its lake, tennis courts, and playground, or to Erdigg Hall, fifteen minutes' drive, for acres of open parkland, French Meadow circular trail, and Wolf's Den natural play area with rope swings, stepping logs and den-building. Just twenty minutes' drive is the landmark Pontcysyllte Aqueduct, part of a magnificent eleven mile World Heritage site. Take leisurely horsedrawn canal trips, or a chugging narrowboat across the aqueduct, followed by lunch at a waterside inn. The Clwydian Range and Dee Valley AONB are 30 minutes' drive, and North Wales coastline under an hour.

City life is convenient too, with Chester for chic shopping and dining, and Liverpool city centre offering the L1 shopping centre, events like the annual River of Light and the Arena's world-class concerts. Wrexham General runs regular train services into Chester and Liverpool Lime Street, while road links are excellent with the A55 North Wales Expressway for the M53 and M56 and Liverpool Airport just 37 miles away.
