

### SEVENOAKS


While a walk around Sevenoaks will take you on a tour of Kentish architecture spanning six centuries, this bustling market town also provides every convenience needed in the 21st century.

### LIFE AT WILDERNESSE HOUSE


The Wildernesse Estate provides a comfortable seating by the sundial folly. huge variety of places, services and experiences to explore, discover and enjoy at your leisure.


## RESTAURANT







# WILDERNESSE HOUSE AND THE MEWS
