


Dating back to 1777 and comprising of 466 hectares of land, Garendon Park is an impressive landscaped parkland just outside the town of Loughborough.





New travel links

A bespoke circular bus service will be introduced across the site providing essential travel for residents to the town centre, via Bishop Meadow Industrial Estate, University and the Science and Enterprise Park. As well as this, a new link road will be built that joins the A512 with the A6 providing easy access via car and improvements to cycling and walking routes will create a traffic free route across the site.





History of *Garendon Park*

Nestled on the northern edge of Charnwood Forest, Garendon Park enjoys Grade II registered parkland surroundings. Prior to the land being developed, there was no public access to the registered park but as part of the renovation of this site, the parkland will be restored and managed for the benefit of the local community.

Plans are underway to retain and restore many of the historic monuments, introduce footpaths, and implement new avenue landscaping with local plant species to reflect the original 'Goosefoot' pattern shown on the original 1777 estate plans. The park itself will provide many opportunities for scenic parkland, lake or woodland walks. Families can also enjoy a host of new amenities, including two new primary schools, sports facilities, open spaces, play areas and community facilities.





School and *Education*


