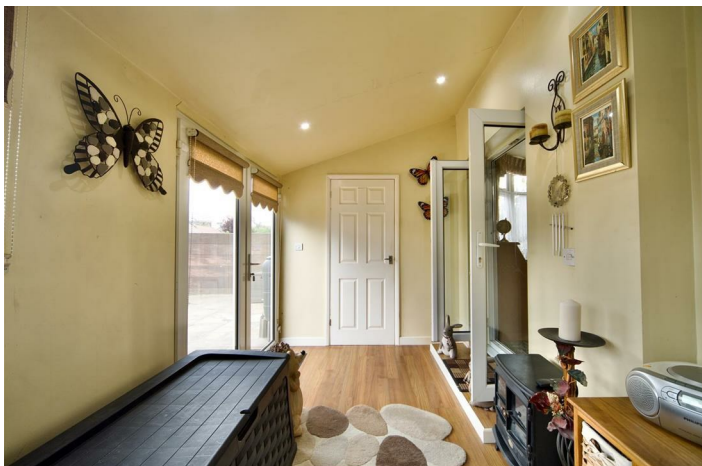

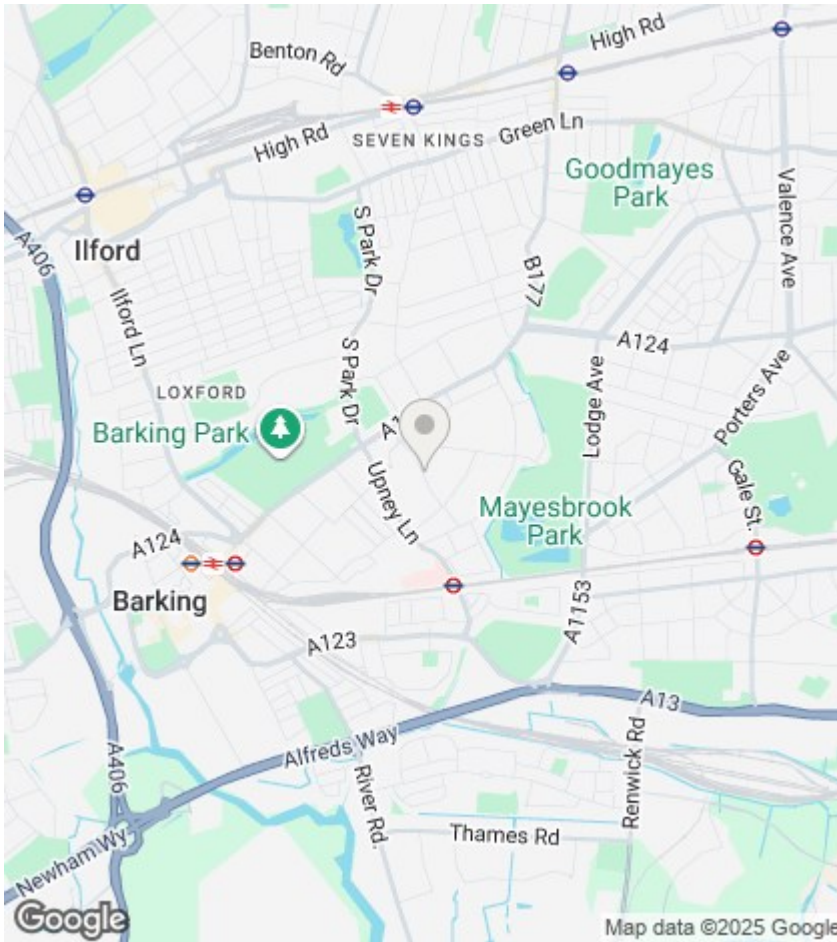
The kitchen area offers plenty of room for everyday cooking and entertaining, while a handy ground floor WC is tucked neatly under the stairs for convenience.

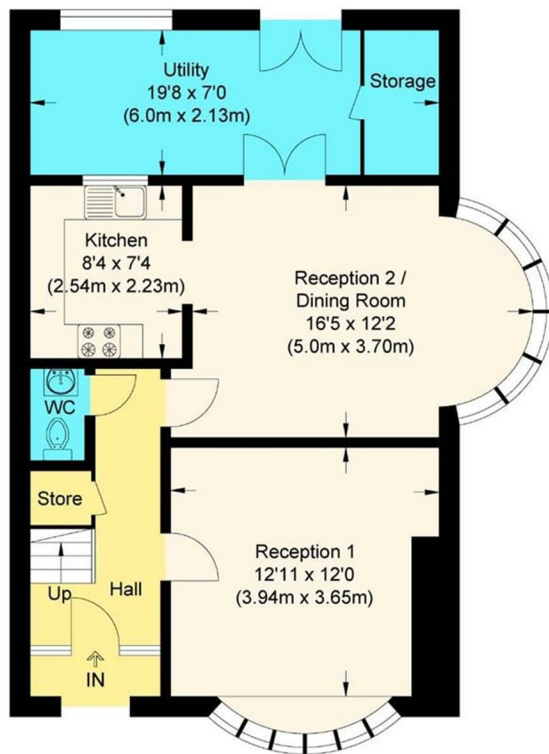

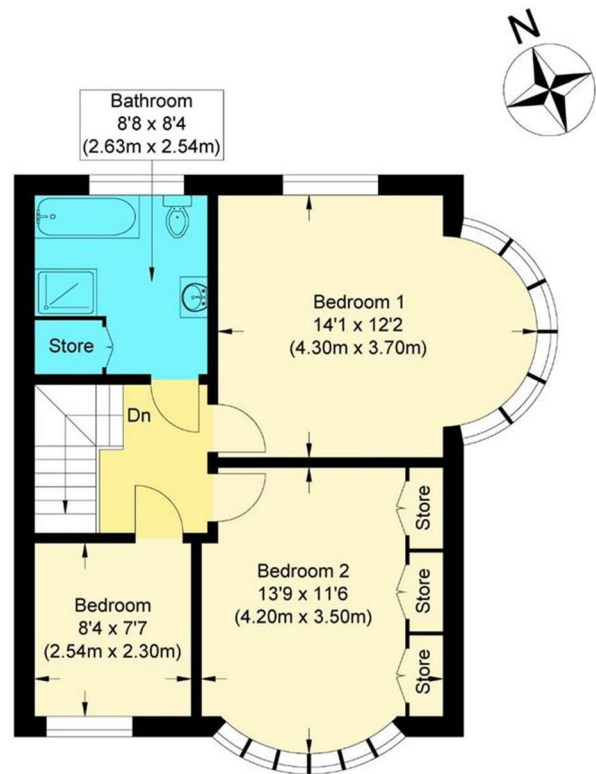
