Farmland surrounds the property and both the Gritstone trail and the Ryles Arms are close-by, providing the opportunity to stroll out for countryside walks and then enjoy a drink or meal afterwards! There is a lovely elevated and tiered rear patio area which, given the south-westerly orientation, enjoys the sun throughout the day. The property is warmed by electric radiators and benefits from double glazing. In brief the accommodation comprises; a good sized 22ft open plan living/dining room with a multi-fuel stove and, an adjoining fitted kitchen area, which is flooded by lots of natural light. At first floor level a long landing provides access into the two bedrooms and the contemporary shower room, which is again bathed in lots of natural light. 

The property has electric thermostat controlled radiators. There is no gas supply. There is no mains water or drainage. Water is supplied via a boar hole and filtration system (the filtration system is located at No 4). There is a shared septic tank for cottages 1,2,3,4. The cost of emptying/ maintenance of the tank is shared equally between the four houses (the vendor can show historic annual costs) and we recommend your solicitor should check the arrangements. There are solar panels on the roof - the vendor has details of historic payments received from selling back to the grid and can provide further information regarding the ownership of the solar panels for your solicitors to check. - Size: -


Upon reaching the village of Sutton from Macclesfield along Hall lane continue onto Hollin Lane where the property can be found on the right after around one mile.
