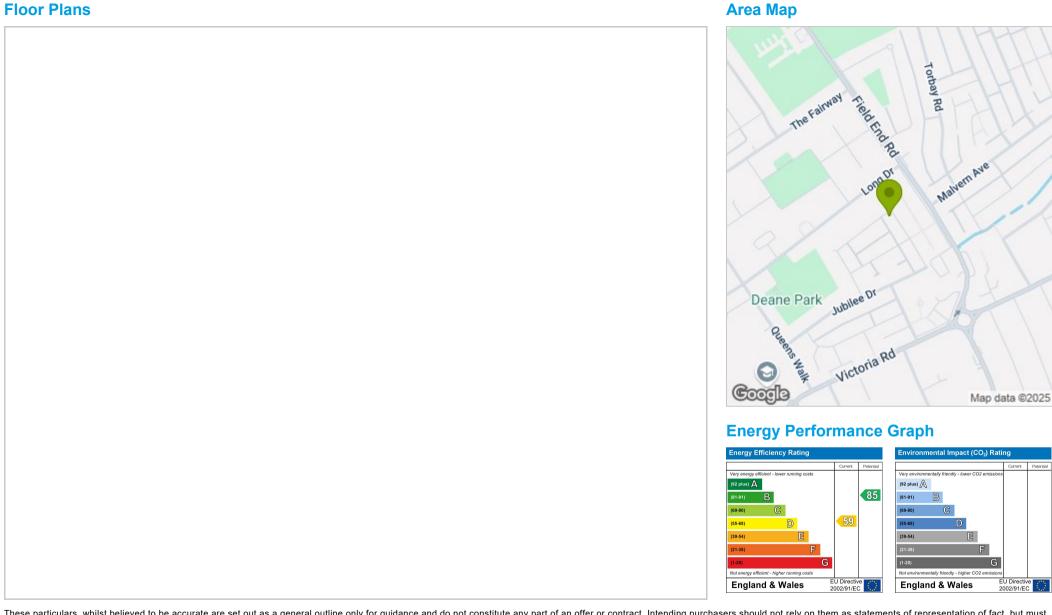
Situation
