About a 20-minute drive or 9 minutes
on the train. Here you'll find
supermarkets, high-street stores, six Green
Flag parks, and a range of global restaurants
and bars that are reflective of the town's
wonderful diversity. If you're in the mood
for culture, there's an arts centre, theatre,
and museum. Plus Someries Castle,
dating back to the 15th century, it's one
of England's earliest brick houses
(it's not actually a castle).

A similar distance in the opposite direction is Milton Keynes. Giving you easy access to two bustling towns. Here you'll also find plenty of great amenities and things to do. There are several attractive lakes, with Willen Lake being the town's most popular park, with its water sports, adventure playground, splash park and picnic areas. For the even more adventurous, head to Xscape. An inclusive entertainment complex with an indoor ski slope, skydiving, and climbing wall. There are also more relaxing things to do here, such as a cinema, bowling alley, bars, and restaurants.

If the bright lights of London are calling, for a shopping expedition, a cultural day out, or drinks with friends, simply take a short walk to Harlington Station, then you could be at London St Pancras in only 45 minutes.

Fans of the great outdoors? Then you'll really appreciate living so close to the Chiltern Hills. This breath-taking area of countryside includes rolling hills, flower-filled woodlands and plenty of pathways to explore by foot or bicycle.

If you're looking to keep the little-ones entertained, it's only 14 miles (20-minute drive) to Gulliver's Land Theme Park in Milton Keynes. There are plenty of rides, play areas and a Dinosaur & Farm Park, all designed for children aged 2 to 13. If they are particularly fond of animals, it's a similar travel time to Whipsnade Zoo, which is just south-west of Luton. The UK's largest zoo, there are thousands of amazing animals to see, from rhinos, giraffes, elephants and lions, to penguins, chimpanzees and owls.

Travelling abroad? Whether it's for business, lying on a golden sandy beach or hitting the ski slopes, it's only 12 miles to Luton Airport (about a 20-minute drive).
