This charming, historic village has a modern, eco-friendly community centre with a shop, café and hall for events, classes, meetings and parties. It was awarded 'The most Ecologicallyfriendly Village Hall in the Country' by the Campaign to Protect Rural England (CPRE).

The award-winning Court Farm Shop is just outside the village, with a butcher and a delicatessen serving own produce and that of other local farmers. In the nearby village of Bishops Cleeve are even more amenities, including several characterful pubs, a leisure centre, independent shops, a Tesco Superstore, and a Lidl.

Stoke Orchard is also surrounded by scenic countryside. Making it easy for

you to escape the everyday by exploring rolling fields and beautiful woodlands.

Travelling around from your new home is simple. Especially by road, with easy access to the M5 motorway, a short 10-minute drive to Tewkesbury, and it's only six miles to Cheltenham with its many shops, supermarkets, restaurants and bars. It's also about six miles to Cheltenham Spa train station and Ashchurch for Tewkesbury train station, both of which are on the Bristol to Birmingham main line.

After dinner, The Brewery Quarter is the place to be — a buzzing destination packed with bars, restaurants, a cinema, bowling alley and regular live events. 


Whether you crave culture, adventure or nature, you're catered for.

Wander along the River Severn, take a boat trip on the Avon, or explore the cobbled streets and charming old buildings. Tewkesbury Abbey is a real highlight, with 900 years of history, towering stonework and stained-glass windows. The town also hosts its own festivals, including the much-loved Medieval Festival and a popular Food & Drink Festival.

## Cheltenham Racecourse.




