

Pick up some freshly-baked cakes and pastries at Dolly's Rockin' Rolls. Relax with a cappuccino and good book at S80 Coffee House. Or head to No.4 in nearby Clowne for drinks, nibbles or an afternoon tea in characterful surroundings. You also have the convenience of a nearby Co-op food store for those day-to-day essentials.

Set within 15,000 acres of rolling hills and forest, there's plenty to see and do at the nearby Welbeck Estate. There's a rum distillery that launched in May 2023 and the Welbeck Abbey Brewery that produces hand-crafted ales. If you're a bit of a foodie, you'll love the award-winning farm shop and café, the dairy that makes artisan cheese,

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and the bakehouse that serves up traditional sourdough loaves. After all that, why not take a leisurely stroll along one of the estate's many walking trails?
