Stepping inside, the sense of history is immediately tangible. The front reception room sets a welcoming tone with rich timber floors and feature fireplace — a space that effortlessly combines cottage charm with modern comfort. Beyond this, the second reception room offers a cosy snug lounge, centred around a log-burning stove set within an exposed brick hearth — the perfect retreat on cooler evenings.







#### The Heart of the Home

To the rear, the kitchen blends rustic warmth with functionality, featuring shaker-style cabinetry, Oak worktops, and natural slate tiled floors. There's a clear sense of craft and continuity in the finishes, with a window overlooking the garden and thoughtful details that make everyday living both practical and enjoyable. A converted former outbuilding now serves as a utility room with WC, providing ideal space for laundry and storage.















## **Upstairs Accommodation**

The first floor offers two generous double bedrooms, each beautifully presented and filled with natural light, plus a third single bedroom that's perfect as a study or nursery. The family bathroom is well-appointed with modern tiling, a shower-over-bath, and a sleek vanity unit — contemporary yet in keeping with the home's tone. From the landing, a pull-down ladder provides access to the loft room, currently arranged as an art studio and study — a versatile area ideal for creative or remote working pursuits.

















A Garden Sanctuary

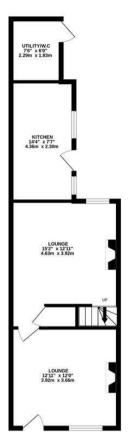
The rear garden is a true highlight — beautifully landscaped with mature planting, raised borders, and a variety of shrubs and trees that bring year-round interest. A paved patio area offers the perfect spot for summer dining and entertaining, while a laid lawn leads down to a large timber shed, offering storage or workshop potential. The garden feels private, peaceful, and lovingly curated — a green oasis in the heart of the village.

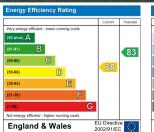

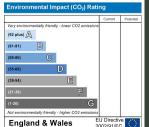

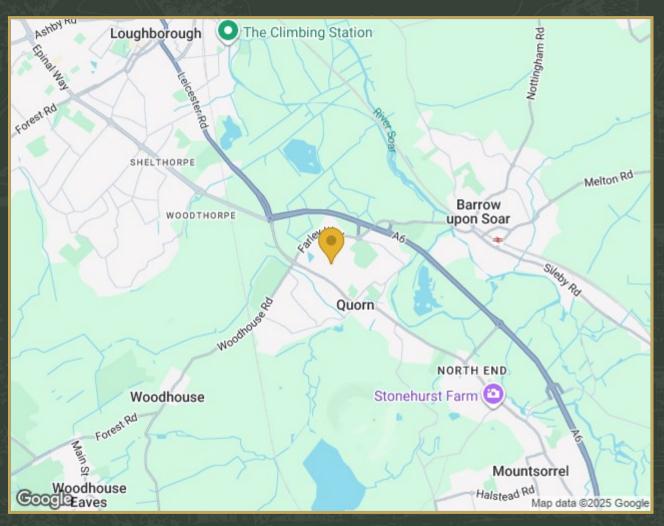
