

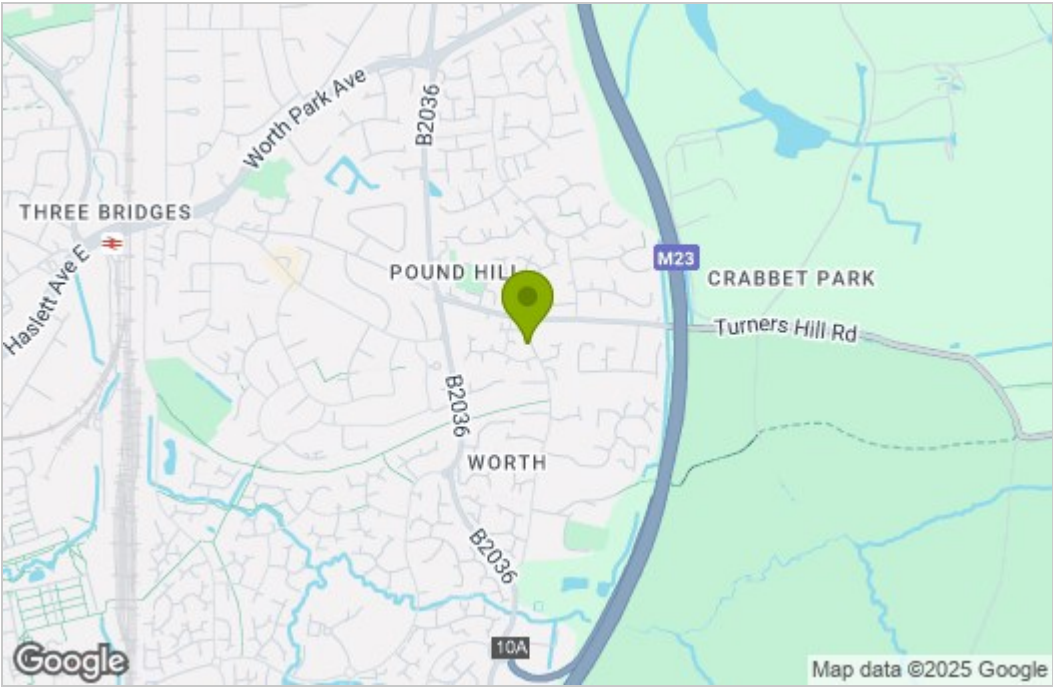

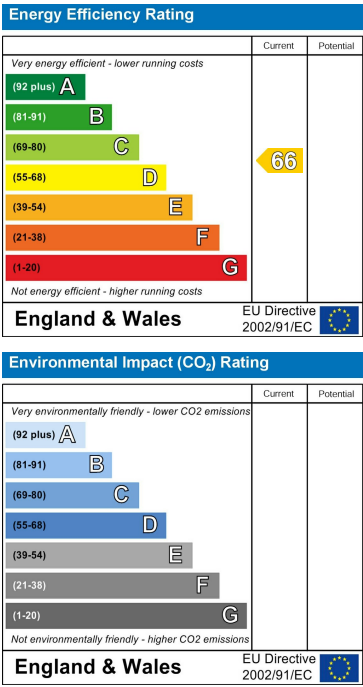

A quintessential chocolate box cottage, built in the 1800s as a workers cottage for the Crabbet Park estate and Manor House. It has been extensively modernised and has open plan living/Dining/Kitchen area, storage cupboard with plumbing for a downstairs cloakroom, two beds and family bathroom upstairs. Situated in a cut de sac forming part of extremely sought after Church Road which leads to St Nicholas, the oldest Saxon Church in the country with beautiful architecture and surrounds. It sits next to Worth Way, a lovely walk which takes you to Rowfant, Crawley Down and on to East Grinstead, perfect for dog walkers and horse riders.
