Bath is a World Heritage City with a wide range of historic and cultural attractions, natural spas, shops, restaurants, theatres and entertainment facilities.



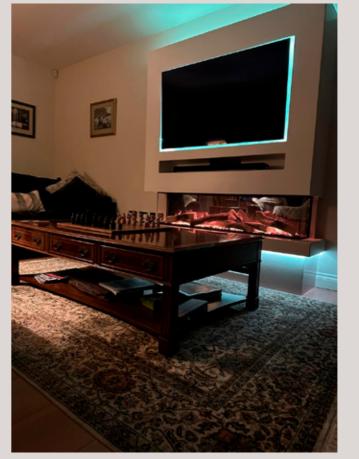

The Property

Sleek and stylish and energy efficient, this modern, first floor, 3-bedroom apartment is set in an exclusive, private development (built in c.2020) in a sought-after prestigious location. A secure communal entrance opens to a hallway with apartment access via stairs or a lift.

Inside, oak wooden flooring stretches along the apartment's hallway and into the principal living space. Zoned underfloor heating is throughout, with sleek lighting and modern fixtures and fittings, particularly Gröhe® and Duravit®, bespoke automated and time-programmable Luxaflex® Powerview electric blinds, heated bathroom mirrors and heated towel rail.

The main living space is open plan, with a well-equipped kitchen: Leich® units, granite worktops, an island unit with breakfast bar, integrated Miele® ovens, Caple integrated wine fridge, dishwasher, and separate fridge & freezer.
