Situation

Communications are area are very good with the M4 J18 about 8 miles south and intercity trains from Chippenham and Kemble to London Paddington. Education is extremely good with primary schools in Leighterton, Sherston and Luckington. There are also excellent secondary schools in Malmesbury, Chippenham and Tetbury. Independent schools include Westonbirt, Beaudesert, Wycliffe as well as others in Bath and Cheltenham. Recreation and sporting facilities are numerous, including Westonbirt Arboretum, walking on the Macmillan and Cotswold Ways and footpath that runs to the rear of the cottage. Cycling on many quiet lanes and golfing at Castle Combe, Bowood, Minchinhampton and Westonbirt. There is also polo at Westonbirt, racing at Cheltenham and Bath, eventing at Badminton and Gatcombe and hunting with the Duke of Beaufort's hounds .


