DESCRIPTION

Circa 1816. Walmsley House is a grade II listed four bedroom detached home offering versatile living accommodation situated within the popular village of Hambleton with easy access to excellent commuter links. This individual characterful home comprises entrance hall, sitting room with original window shutters, to room with coal effect burning stove, dining room with original window shutters, kitchen with gas Aga, electric companion Aga, integrated dishwasher, original window shutters, utility room and w.c to the ground floor. To the first floor bedroom one has original Georgian cast iron fireplace with surround, original built in cupboard along with an en-suite shower room. Bedroom two has an original Georgian cast iron fireplace with surround and two original built in cupboards. Bedroom three has an original Georgian cast iron fireplace with surround. Bedroom four is currently used as an office. The first floor also benefits from a dressing room and a family bathroom. To the outside of the property there is an electric gate leading to a large driveway with parking for several vehicles along with gardens laid to lawn and a graveled area which is perfect for summer dining. The property also benefits from a large garage (3000 square feet) which could also be used as a business premises subject to planning. LOCATION

Hambleton is a popular village which is conveniently located approximately 5 miles from the A1M providing good commuter access to Leeds and other surrounding major cities and towns. Village amenities include a village shop, a church, The Owl Hotel and a public house. Primary education is provided by the local C of E school, rated highly by Ofsted. Also, located on a good bus route with direct connections to Selby/York/Leeds.

DIRECTIONS

Leave Selby via the A63, Leeds Road in a westerly direction. Follow the road over the level crossing through the village of Thorpe Willoughby. At the roundabout take the second exit and follow the signpost A63 to Leeds. This road will lead into Hambleton, take the left hand turn onto Gateforth Lane and the property is located on the right hand side identified by our Hunters exclusive board.

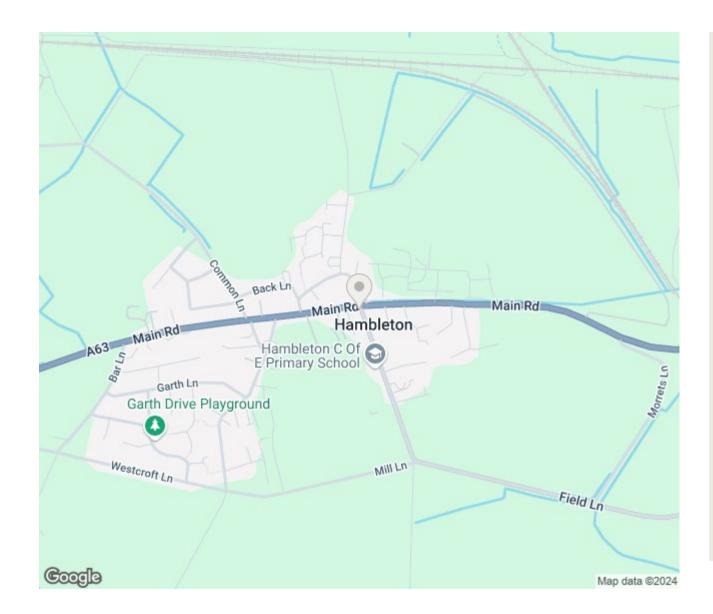
