Accommodation

Entrance

A charming flagstone pathway guides you to a welcoming porch, illuminated by an exterior light. A classic panelled front door opens into the inviting entrance hall, setting the tone for the home's character and warmth.

Entrance Hall

A welcoming reception area featuring elegant period details, including a picture rail, moulded skirting boards, architraves, and decorative wall panelling. The oak-effect laminate flooring adds warmth and style, complemented by a radiator providing comfort. A staircase rises gracefully to the first floor, while panelled doors open to the main ground floor rooms, all accessed through a charming barn-style door.

Lounge

17' 9" + Bay x 13' 5" (5.41m + Bay x 4.09m)

An elegantly presented main reception room featuring a charming single-glazed, multi-pane window overlooking the front garden. The focal point is a carved, period-style fire surround with a hearth and mains gas living flame fire, adding warmth and character. Additional period details include ornate ceiling coving, a moulded picture rail, skirting boards, and architraves. The room also benefits from a TV point, telephone point, and radiator.

Dining Room

15' 2" + Wardrobe/Bay x 13' 2" Max (4.62m + Wardrobe/Bay x 4.01m Max)

A lovely entertaining space offering ample room for a large dining table. The room features elegant period ceiling mouldings and coving, a moulded picture rail, and detailed skirting boards and architraves. A single glazed multi-pane feature window to the front provides a pleasant outlook over the garden, while a carved period-style fire surround with an open fireplace creates a charming focal point. Additional features include a radiator, double doors opening to a built-in desk and study area with shelving above, and further double doors leading to a cupboard.

Kitchen Breakfast Room

13' 7" x 11' 10" (4.14m x 3.61m)

A well-appointed kitchen breakfast room featuring exposed ceiling beams and inset lighting that enhance its character. A single-glazed multi-pane window provides delightful views over the rear garden. The kitchen is fitted with an extensive range of timber-panelled units topped with laminated work surfaces and complemented by decorative tiled surrounds. The design includes an inset one-and-a-half composite sink with drainer and mixer tap, a variety of cupboards and drawers, and matching wall-mounted cabinets with display units. Integrated appliances include a dishwasher, fridge, and freezer. The chimney breast recess accommodates a range-style LPG-fired Belling cooker with grill, six-burner hob, and warming plate. A radiator completes this inviting and practical space.

Utility Room

A spacious and practical utility room featuring timber-effect flooring and a radiator for comfort. A multi-pane window provides pleasant views over the rear garden, filling the space with natural light. The room is fitted with a range of base and wall-mounted cupboards offering excellent storage, complemented by laminated work surfaces. There is ample space and plumbing for a washing machine and tumble dryer, along with room for an upright fridge freezer. A panelled door opens to a convenient walk-in larder cupboard, ideal for additional storage.

Shower Room

A downstairs shower room featuring a white suite with low-level YWCA and pedestal wash basin set against a tiled flashback. The glazed corner shower enclosure includes a wall-mounted mains shower, offering both practicality and modern appeal. A single glazed side window allows natural light to brighten the space, while the high ceiling enhances the sense of openness. Finished with a sleek chrome heated towel rail for added comfort.

Landing

A bright and airy landing featuring a window that overlooks the rear garden and offers lovely views of the surrounding countryside. The space includes a radiator for warmth and a ceiling hatch providing access to the loft storage area. Double doors open to an airing cupboard housing the gas-fired boiler and fitted with practical slatted shelving.

Bedroom One

16' 6" + Wardrobe x 10' 7" + Window Recess (5.03m + Wardrobe x 3.23m + Window Recess)

A generously sized double bedroom featuring excellent ceiling height and two multi-pane double-glazed windows to the front, allowing plenty of natural light. The room is enhanced by moulded skirting boards and architraves, adding a touch of elegance. Extensive fitted furniture includes wardrobes, overhead cupboards, drawer units, a dressing table, and matching bedside cabinets. Additional features include a TV point for convenience.

Bedroom Two

13' Max x 10' (3.96m Max x 3.05m)

A well-proportioned double bedroom featuring a multi-pane double-glazed window to the front, filling the room with natural light. The space includes a radiator, moulded skirting boards, and architraves that add a refined finish. Fitted bedroom furniture provides excellent storage and includes a wardrobe. A TV point completes this comfortable and functional room.

Bedroom Three

12' 3" Into Wardrobe x 7' 8" (3.73m Into Wardrobe

x 2.34m)

A comfortable double bedroom with a window overlooking the rear garden, offering a pleasant southerly aspect and views across open fields. The room features a charming window seat, radiator, and detailed moulded skirting boards and architraves. Fitted furniture provides ample storage and includes wardrobes, a shelf unit, drawer unit, and a dressing table.

Bathroom

A spacious and elegant bathroom featuring a period-style white suite that includes a low-level WC, bidet, and pedestal wash basin with tiled splashback. The panelled bath is fitted with a mains shower tap arrangement and surrounded by complementary tiling. A separate glazed shower cubicle houses a wall-mounted mains shower for added convenience. The room is finished with inset ceiling lighting, an extractor fan, tiled flooring, a radiator, and a heated towel rail, creating a refined and comfortable space.

Outside

Front

At the front, a wrought iron gate and railings open onto an attractive lawned garden with a flagstone pathway leading to the front door. The area features a storm porch and outside lighting.

Rear Garden

A beautifully maintained, level rear garden laid mainly to lawn and enjoying a sunny southerly aspect with wonderful views across adjoining fields. An extensive paved patio creates an ideal suntrap, perfect for outdoor entertaining. A timber pergola adorned with mature climbing plants adds charm and character, complemented by outside lighting and a convenient water tap. The garden features natural stone borders and well-stocked flowerbeds with an array of mature trees, plants, and shrubs. Enclosed by established hedging and timber fencing, the space also includes a timber garden shed. Steps lead up to a raised timber-decked seating area, complete with an additional tap and power point, providing the perfect setting for a hot tub.


















