Cooper Cottage, Main Street, Taddington.

A charming two double bedroom, double fronted end cottage with immense character features revealed and retained.

Sitting Room Two

14' 5" x 11' 4" (4.39m x 3.45m) A delightful character first reception room with an arched fireplace and a multi-fuel stove. The floor is stone flagged and there are ceiling beams. Plenty of storage with built-in cupboards. Lovely village views to the front. Radiator and wall lights.

Sitting Room

14' 5" x 11' 3" (4.39m x 3.43m) Also, a very characterful room with an arched fireplace including an Aga multi-fuel stove. There are ceiling beams, wall lights and a radiator.

Kitchen Dining Room

22' 2" x 9' 7" (6.76m x 2.92m)

Two storey galleried living kitchen with vaulted, high ceiling which has roof lights.

Further windows to the rear overlook the rear courtyard and a glazed stable door gives access to the exterior.

There is an excellent fitted kitchen in glossy white with granite style tops and a full complement of built-in appliances by Smeg comprising, oven, hob, hood and integrated fridge and a dishwasher and washer space.

The oil boiler is concealed.

The stone flagged floor continues from the sitting room and there is space for a large dining table. Stairs rise to the gallery landing, bedrooms, and bathroom.

Landing

Fine views over the kitchen and rear courtyard. Exposed beams.

Bedroom One

12' 6" x 11' 9" (3.81m x 3.58m)

A front window has village views and there are triple wardrobes. The pine boards have been revealed and waxed. There are ceiling beams and access to the roof space.

Bedroom Two

8' 9" x 11' 4" (2.67m x 3.45m) Purlins are exposed and front windows have village views.

Bathroom

6' 2" x 8' (1.88m x 2.44m) P shaped whirlpool bath, ideal standard wash basin and a W/C. A Velux above floods the room with light.

Gardens

A forecourt is used for parking. The rear gardens are on two levels and include a wide sunken southerly facing terrace patio. The upper terrace has a path and a small shrub garden.

Outbuilding

Double doors to a spacious store place.
