Lilium House is only 7.74 miles from Central London and 20.39 miles (44 mins)* from Gatwick Airport.

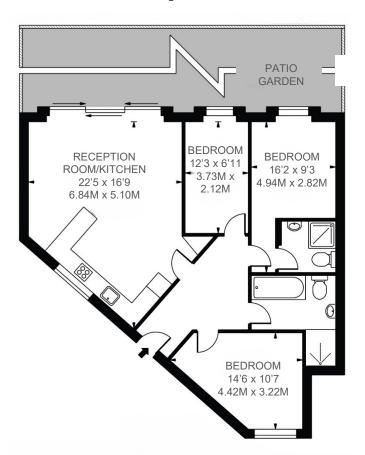
There are also regular bus services – including the 50 and 109 to Croydon Town Centre and the 255 to Pollards Hill.







No.1 - 857 sq ft

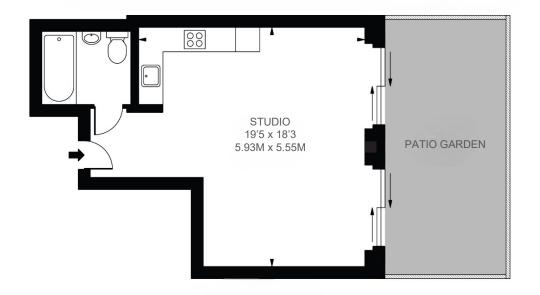


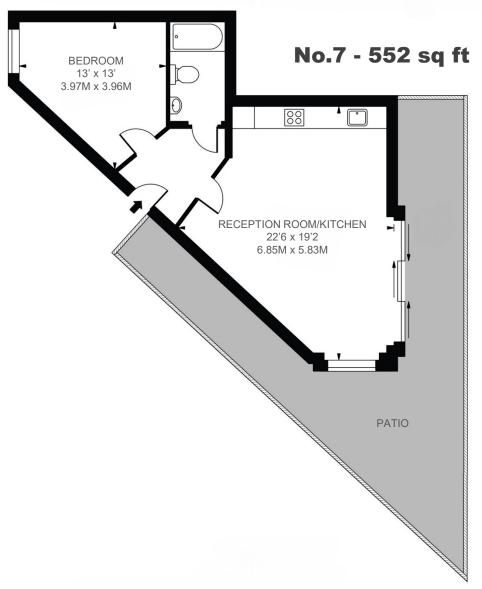


Floor plans



No.2 - 396 sq ft



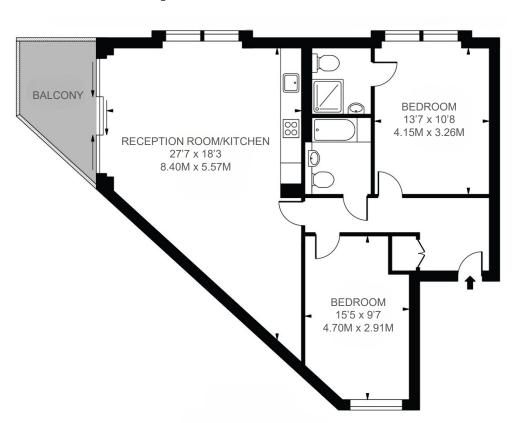
