

1 Westwood Place

WESTWOOD LANE, NORMANDY, GUILDFORD, GU3 2JE

Set within the historic village of Normandy, 1 Westwood Place enjoys a location steeped in rural heritage. Once part of the Westwood Estate, the area was known for its agricultural roots and woodland surroundings.

This imposing residence sits proudly on Westwood Lane, with a striking facade and ample parking to the front. Accessed via a communal entrance shared with just one other apartment, the property opens into a central hallway with two useful storage cupboards at each end.

At the heart of the home is a stunning living and dining room, measuring an impressive 23'1" x 22'2", featuring wooden parguet flooring, a fireplace, and a bay window that frames views over the mature rear garden. A door leads into a garden room, which opens via sliding doors onto a York stone patio.

The kitchen is fitted with classic white shaker-style units, an integrated double electric oven, electric hob with extractor, and space for a freestanding washing machine, tumble dryer, and fridge/freezer. A sink under the window offers a pleasant outlook to the garden.

The master bedroom features a large bay window, built-in wardrobes, and a three-piece en-suite shower room. A second double bedroom, also with built-in wardrobes, provides comfortable accommodation for guests or family. The main bathroom includes a P-shaped bath with shower over, sink, WC, and a heated towel rail.

Outside, the generous garden is an unusual find on an apartment such as this. A large York stone patio leads to an expansive lawn, bordered by a mix of deciduous and evergreen trees, offering privacy and seasonal interest. At the top of the garden sits a summer house, ideal for a quiet drink or use as a home office, with views over adjacent fields. A garage to the side of the property includes power points and lighting.

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SITUATION



DIRECTIONS

From Guildford town centre, head west on the A31 (Farnham Road) and continue for approximately 3 miles. Take the exit onto the B3000, signposted for Normandy and Pirbright. Follow the B3000 through Flexford, passing through the hamlets of Wanborough and Christmas Pie, and continue under the railway bridge. Westwood Place will be found on the left-hand side, set back from the road with ample parking to the front.

1 Westwood Place is a spacious and characterful ground-floor apartment in the historic village of Normandy, featuring two double bedrooms, generous living space and a large private garden.




Westwood Lane, Normandy, Guildford, GU3
