

Old Malthouse Cottage

A charming, three bedroom, stone built character cottage nestled in the heart of Llantwit Major 'Old Town' with courtyard style rear garden and great connectivity to local amenities, Heritage Coastline and transport links.

A timber stable style door opens into the beamed kitchen/diner with stunning original stone fireplace with low level fitted cupboards, integrated sink with mixer taps over, electric oven, gas hob and slimline dishwasher to remain. A naturally bright room enhanced by a dual aspect with windows to front and rear. Beyond lies a practical tiled rear hall allowing access to a WC and rear garden. A striking stone arched door connects the kitchen to the sitting room with fitted carpet, beamed ceilings and original stone fireplace with inset burner, wall mounted uplighting. In addition, a large window

frames the front forecourt with glazed French doors linking the rear garden well.

Inglenook stone stairs rise to the first-floor landing. Upstairs are three bedrooms of which bedrooms one and two are front facing double bedrooms with high ceilings, windows to the front and pendant lights. Bedroom two benefits from built in wardrobes with high level shelving over. Bedroom 3 lies to the rear of the property and is currently used as a dressing room with open wardrobes, hanging rails, shelves and drawers fitted. The family

bathroom is well appointed with tiled flooring. A threepiece suite comprises a traditionally styled pedestal basin, panelled bath with centrally fitted taps and mains fed wall mounted shower, low level WC and frosted window to the rear elevation.

To the front a walled forecourt has been thoughtfully landscaped with easy maintenance in mind and draws you into the cottage from the start. The rear garden has been practically landscaped in a 'courtyard style' with predominantly laid patio with planted borders and side pedestrian gate.




