A spacious three-bedroom mid -terrace family home, situated on a non-through road, with easy access to the City Centre.

An obscure glass panel door with fan light above leads into the ENTRANCE HALL. A further door leads into the spacious open plan LOUNGE/DINING ROOM, which is dual aspect with windows to front and rear. Within the LOUNGE are fitted base units and wall mounted display shelving in the recesses of the original chimney breast. Stairs rise to 1st floor accommodation. High-quality laminate wood flooring which continues into: The KITCHEN with glazed door and window to side gives

access and views into the rear garden. Fitted range of base and wall mounted units with oak effect role top work surface with splashback tiling over. Integrated oven with four burner gas hob above. Space and plumbing for washing machine and fridge/freezer. Wall mounted gas fire combination boiler.

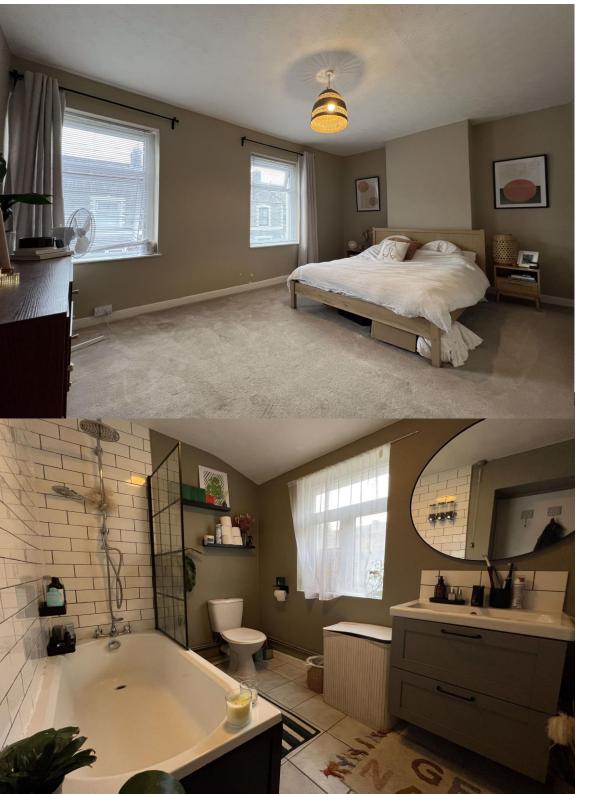
The FAMILY BATHROOM has a white three-piece suite which includes: a panel bath with mixer tap with rainfall and handset shower over. Low-level WC and wash and basin with storage below. The room has ceramic tile flooring plus splashback tiling above the sink and bath.

The first floor LANDING with study area, has feature wood panelling to dado height and painted floorboards, a loft inspection point and doors into bedroom accommodation. BEDROOM ONE is a large double bedroom with two windows to front overlooking the roadside. BEDROOM TWO is also a comfortable double bedroom with window to rear with views into the garden. It has an original cast iron feature fireplace. BEDROOM THREE is dual aspect with windows to side and rear. It will house a double bed, but is currently presented as a dressing room.

To the rear is a landscaped enclosed garden with ornate gravel and flagstone laid pathways, which lead to a lawned garden, with deck patio. Raised shrub and flower borders. The garden is boarded by brick and stone walling, plus overlap with fencing.
