Sitting Room 12' 2" x 12' 10" (3.7m x 3.9m) into bay
Front aspect main reception with bay window. Stone fire place - inset gas fire.

Dining Room 13' 5" x 12' 2" (4.1m x 3.7m)
A second reception. Stairs to the first floor. Rear aspect window.

Kitchen 9' 10" x 6' 7" (2.99m x 2.0m)
Galley style kitchen with split stable door into the garden.

Utility 6' 11" x 5' 9" (2.1m x 1.76m)
Additional ground floor room - through from the kitchen. Ideal space perhaps for an extra bathroom.

First Floor

Bedroom 1 12' 1" x 10' 6" (3.68m x 3.2m)
A front aspect bedroom. Original fireplace.

Bathroom 12' 1" x 12' 2" (3.69m x 3.7m)
A large family bathroom, with panelled bath, w/c and basin.

Second Floor

Bedroom 2 12' 1" x 10' 10" (3.68m x 3.3m)
Front aspect double bedroom. Sloped ceiling.

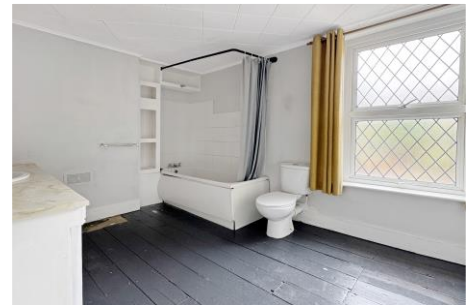
Bedroom 3 12' 1" x 11' 2" (3.68m x 3.4m)
A rear aspect double bedroom with built in cupboard and storage.

Outside

A walled front garden. The back garden is laid to patio.
