With composite and obscure glazed front door opening into:

Entrance Hall

With stairs rising to first floor landing, large window to front, storage cupboards, smoke alarm, ceiling lighting, power points, Woodpecker engineered 21mm thick Chepstow oak flooring with underfloor heating and doors to rooms.

Cloakroom

Comprising Kartell UK K-Vit sanitary ware, insert ceiling downlighting, extractor fan, Woodpecker engineered 21mm thick Chepstow oak flooring with underfloor heating.

Kitchen Diner - 21'3" x 13'11"

A Benchmark Kitchen comprising an array of eye and base level cupboards and drawers with complimentary 30mm white granite work surface, large island, NEFF appliances including dishwasher, oven, washing machine, fridge, freezer, induction hob and extractor. Insert ceiling downlighting, window to front, further windows and French doors to rear garden, Woodpecker engineered 21mm thick Chepstow oak flooring with underfloor heating, door to:

Utility Room

With matching Benchmark eye and base level cupboards and drawers with complimentary 30mm white granite work surface, insert ceiling downlighting, window to front, further door to rear garden, Woodpecker engineered 21mm thick Chepstow oak flooring with underfloor heating.

Living Room - 21'3" x 13'11"

With window to front and French doors to rear garden, feature fireplace, ceiling lighting, TV and power points, Woodpecker engineered 21mm thick Chepstow oak flooring.

Playroom/Home Office - 15'3" x 7'8"

With window and French doors to rear garden, ceiling lighting, TV and power points, Woodpecker engineered 21mm thick Chepstow oak flooring.

First Floor Landing

With storage cupboard, ceiling lighting, fitted carpet, window to front, wall mounted radiator, smoke alarm, power point and doors to rooms.

Bedroom 1 - 21'3" x 12'5"

With windows to front and rear aspects, ceiling lighting, wall mounted radiator, fitted carpet, TV and power points, door to:

En-suite

Bedroom 2 - 12'8" x 10'3"

With window to front, wall mounted radiator, ceiling lighting, TV and power points and fitted carpet.

Bedroom 3 - 13'11" x 8'6"

With window to rear, wall mounted radiator, ceiling lighting, TV and power points and fitted carpet.

Bedroom 4 - 11'1" x 10'1"

With window to rear, wall mounted radiator, ceiling lighting, TV and power points and fitted carpet.

Family Bathroom - 11'1" x 9'6"

Comprising Kartell UK K-Vit sanitary ware, insert ceiling downlighting, extractor fan, wall mounted heated towel rail, obscure window to front, tiled flooring with underfloor heating.

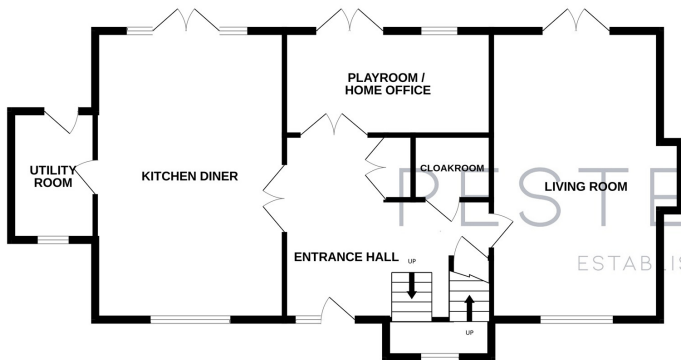

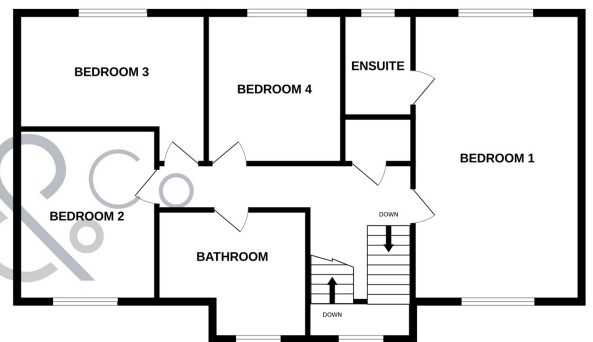
