Ground Floor

Entrance Hall

An impressive vestibule style entrance hall with black and white tiled floor and wooden front doors. High ceiling into the original tower, with seven windows. Central heating radiator. Glass door and window to the living space.

Living Space

An impressive living space with vaulted painted timber ceiling and three large windows giving views of the Pier Pavillion and Bristol Channel. Fitted carpet. Three central heating radiators. Picture rails. Open to the kitchen and the side entrance lobby. Stairs to the lower floor. Power and TV points.

Kitchen

Fully fitted kitchen with a range of wall units, base units and tall larder cupboards, black granite work surfaces and a matching central island. Integrated Smeg appliances comprising an electric oven, grill, microwave, five burner gas hob, extractor hood and dishwasher. Integrated wine chiller. Plumbing for washing machine. Recess for American style fridge freezer. High vaulted ceiling with three Velux windows. Part tiled walls. Power points. Double glazed panel Oak doors to the side entrance lobby.

Side Lobby

A spacious entrance area with built in storage, a high vaulted ceiling and open to the living space. Tiled floor. Doors to the kitchen and WC. Two central heating radiators.

Cloakroom

Tiled floor and part tiled walls. Central heating radiator. Suite comprising a wash hand basin and WC with concealed cistern. Recessed light. Extractor.

Fitted carpet. Central heating radiator. Power points. Fitted recessed shelving. Built in cupboard with hot water cylinder. Recessed lights.

Bedroom 1

Main bedroom with dressing room, en-suite and access onto a private patio garden. Fitted carpet. Recessed lights. Central heating radiator. Power, TV and phone points. uPVC double glazed double doors to the garden at the front. Open to the dressing room at the rear.

Dressing Area

Fitted carpet. Shelving and clothes rails. Recessed lights. Oak door to the en-suite shower room.

En-Suite

Fully tiled with a suite comprising a shower cubicle with mixer shower, WC with concealed cistern and a wash hand basin with storage below. Heated towel rail. Extractor. Recessed lights. Fitted mirror.

Bedroom 2

Double bedroom with wooden double glazed bay window to the side. Recessed lights. Fitted carpet. Central heating radiator. Power and TV points.

Bedroom 3

The second bedroom with uPVC double glazed double doors leading to the patio garden area. Central heating radiator. Fitted carpet. Power and phone point. Recessed lights.

Bathroom

A fully tiled bathroom with suite comprising of a panelled bath with mixer shower and glass screen, WC with concealed cistern and a wash hand basin. Heated towel rail. Recessed lights. Extractor. Large fitted wall mirror. Wooden window.

Outside

Front

An enclosed garden with views of the Bristol Channel and Pier Pavillion. Areas of natural stone paving, artificial grass and mature planting. Steps up to the front door and gated access to the side entrance. Steps down to the lower ground floor garden area that is accessed also from the bedrooms. Original stone boundary walls. Iron railings and gates.

Lower Garden

Natural stone paved patio. Outside lights. Ample space for garden furniture and with a good level of privacy.

Parking Area

The property benefits from two gated undercroft parking spaces. In this area, there is also a dedicated secure store area for the use of the property exclusively.

Tenure

We have been informed by the vendor that the property is held on a leasehold basis (CYM376483) with a share of the freehold (CYM605831). The lease is for 999 years from 1st January 2006 (980 remaining). The 4 properties in this part of the development, the original Victorian baths, have formed a management company and pay a service charge to this for general maintenance and buildings insurance.

Council Tax Band

The Council Tax band for this property is H, which equates to a charge of £4248.02 for the year 2025/26.

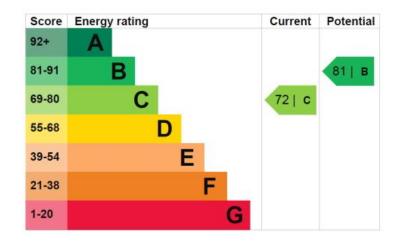
